HOW TO RESEARCH YOUR OWN CLASSIC FORD:

1. Visit <http://www.martiauto.com/reports2.cfm> and put in your car information, then select from the available types of reports. There are some additional deals going on for these reports right now where you can save a little cash or upgrade an already previous report for a discount.
2. Visit the following link that is a part of shopfordgear.com:
http://www.shopfordgear.com/find.asp?session=17899D9C0C99411DBEC02D3B34D3F4C4&search_type=by_dept&dept_id=16&d=16&c=48652YHNOREJJK4&s=
From here, you can select the type of report you would like to have created. This may also be what use to be referred to as the Ford 999 report for your vehicle.
3. Check out online articles, blogs and discussion threads to find out what other folks have dug up (via from the underneath their carpet, discussions with dealers who sold the vehicle originally, DMV contacts, etc. – like this article titled "[Researching The History of Your Mustang](#)" from Mustang Monthly's May 2012 issue).
4. Contact the Mustang Club of America for additional help or research at www.mustang.org. Their website has several different references to questions and discussion about this.
5. Talk to some of the folks in our club that have already gone through completing this process. They'll be able to give you some tips.
