- You also can apply for **Advance Parole** if you have an **emergency situation**. You must provide evidence of the emergency. Example: if you are traveling to visit a sick family member, you must have a letter written by the doctor (on the hospital's office paper) that explains your family member's health condition. If you are traveling to attend a funeral, you must have a copy of the death certificate. A letter explaining why you are requesting advance parole will also accompany your application; we will help you with this letter at your appointment
