INSTRUCTIONS FOR HEARING ON APPEAL OF AUTOMATIC FINE

Please be advised that other cases have been scheduled for the same time. Therefore, your case may not be called exactly at the time set forth on this notice.

At the automatic fine hearing, the Florida Elections Commission will decide whether Respondent's campaign treasurers report was timely filed or whether there were unusual circumstances that excuse his failure to timely file his report.

Rule 2B-1.0055, Florida Administrative Code, defines unusual circumstances as "uncommon, rare or sudden events over which the actor has no control and which directly result in the failure to act in accordance with the filing requirements. Circumstances which allow for time in which to take those steps necessary to assure compliance with the filing requirement shall be deemed not to constitute unusual circumstances."

The hearing will be conducted pursuant to Section 106.07(8)(c), *Florida Statutes*, if Respondent is a candidate, a political committee, or an electioneering communications organization; Section 106.04(8)(c), *Florida Statutes*, if Respondent is a committee of continuous existence; or Section 106.29(3)(c), *Florida Statutes*, if Respondent is a political party; and Commission Rules 2B-1.005, 1.0052, & 1.0055, *Florida Administrative Code*.

The Commission will electronically record the meeting. Although the Commission's recording is considered the official record of the hearing, the Respondent may provide, at his own expense, a certified court reporter to also record the hearing.

Before making a decision, the Commission will review the written documents submitted by Respondent and staff at least ten days before the hearing and the information presented at the hearing. Rule 2B-1.005, *Florida Administrative Code*, provides that <u>unless good cause is shown</u>, the Commission will not consider any written document unless it has been filed with the Commission Clerk at least ten days before the hearing.

When the case is called, the Chair will read a brief statement and may ask the Respondent and his attorney, if one is present, to state their names for the record. Respondent will then have time to present his case to the Commission. Witnesses may be called to testify on Respondent's behalf. If Respondent calls witnesses, the staff attorney may cross-examine those witnesses after Respondent's questioning is finished. After Respondent's presentation, staff will have the same amount of time to present its case. If the staff attorney calls witnesses, Respondent may cross-examine those witnesses after staff's questioning is finished.

At any time during the presentations the Commissioners may ask questions of Respondent, his attorney, the witnesses, and staff. After the presentations are concluded, the Commissioners will discuss the case and decide whether Respondent's report was timely filed or whether there were unusual circumstances that excuse his failure to file timely his report. The Commission will make a decision by a majority vote of those members present and voting.

After the Commission meeting, the Commission will send Respondent a written order reflecting the Commission's decision. If the Commission upholds the fine, Respondent will have 30 days to pay the fine.

SUMMARY: Florida Mainstreet Merchants is an electioneering communications organization (ECO) registered with the Division of Elections. The ECO's chair is Richard A. McAllister, and its treasurer is Sally West House. Samantha Hunter Padgett is the attorney representing the ECO in this appeal.

The ECO is appealing the fine claiming that there was confusion concerning its registration status. Additionally, Ms. West was not notified of the report due dates when she received the ECO's credentials. Ms. Padgett submitted an affidavit from Ms. West reflecting that Ms. West was unsure whether the ECO was considered a new or pre-existing committee; therefore, their registration form had to be corrected several times. Ms. West further states in her affidavit, "After conversing with the Division employee, I did not understand that Mainstreet would be required to submit the reports within two days...I felt two weeks was a reasonable period of time in which to submit reports."

Section 106.0703(8), Florida Statutes states "An electioneering communications organization shall, within 2 days after receiving its initial password or secure sign-on...electronically file the periodic reports that would have been required pursuant to this section..."

Tom Burkes who works for the Division of Elections, provided an affidavit stating that although he cannot recall the entire conversation with Ms. West, it is his practice to always discuss with ECOs the requirement to file back reports within two days of receipt of credentials.

This case has the same fact pattern as FEC 11-036.

Dear Florida Elections Commission:

The Florida Division of Elections (Division) issued a notice of imposition of fine dated October 4, 2010 to Mr. Richard A. McAllister, Chairperson, Florida Mainstreet Merchants, at 227 South Adams Street, Tallahassee, FL 32302. Mr. McAllister's phone number is 850-222-4082.

Pursuant to Rule 2B-1.005, Florida Administrative Code, this letter serves as a notice to appeal the imposition of fine and a request for hearing by personal appearance before the Commission. We ask the Commission to exercise the authority granted in Secs. 106.265 and 106.0703, Florida Statutes, and reduce the fine in whole or in part based on the mitigating circumstances in this case. A copy of the imposition of fine issued by the filing officer is included in the attached Exhibits.

Timeline of Events

On May 22, 2009, the United States District Court Northern District of Florida in *Broward Coalition v. Browning* struck down as unconstitutional Florida's law regarding Electioneering Communications Organizations (ECOs). Prior to this time, Florida Mainstreet Merchants (Mainstreet), an ECO registered with the Florida Division of Elections, consistently issued timely the reports due under the Florida law. Following the *Broward Coalition* decision, Mainstreet lawfully reported its activities to the federal government. *See* Exhibit A.

On May 28, 2010, HB 131 was signed into law, reenacting reporting requirements for ECOs in Florida. On June 3, 2010, the Florida Division of Elections issued a memo stating new registration information would be available on its website. *See* Exhibit B. This information was not immediately available on the website. *See* "Affidavit of Sally West". As a result, Mainstreet was not able to immediately register with the Division. *Id.* Form DS-DE 103 as filed by Mainstreet on July 22, 2010 shows the form was revised as of July 2010. *See* Exhibit C.

It was not readily apparent to Ms. Sally West House (Ms. West), Treasurer of Florida Mainstreet Merchants, how she should register Mainstreet. *See* Affidavit. She inquired of the Division if it should be regarded as a new organization or as a pre-existing organization. *Id* She received verbal guidance from the Division that she should register as a new organization. *Id* Ms. West filed the registration papers with the Division via certified letter on July 22, 2010. *See* Exhibits C and D.

Following the submission of the registration papers, the Division called Rick McAllister, Chairperson of Mainstreet, to tell him changes to the DS-DE 103 were necessary. *See* Affidavit. No written notification was given. *Id.* Mr. McAllister forwarded this message to Ms. West. *Id.* Ms. West was out of the office; she made the requested changes and filed the corrected document promptly upon her return. *See* Exhibit E. The Division requested additional changes, and a third registration form was filed. *See* Exhibit F. Ms. West filed the registration form three times due to requests for changes required by the Division. Ms. West complied with each request, and no additional changes were demanded after the third filing.

The Division issued a letter to Mainstreet on August 4, 2010 indicating the Application for Certification was received on August 3, 2010 and Mainstreet was now considered an active organization. See Exhibit G. Following the letter, Ms. West had additional questions, so she called the Division for clarification regarding the reports requested and the time allowed for filing of said reports. See Affidavit. Ms. West was assured by the Division staff person with whom she spoke that reports submitted in a timely manner would be acceptable. Id. After conversing with the Division, Ms. West did not understand she would be required to submit the reports within two days. Id. She felt two weeks was a reasonable period of time in which to submit reports. Id.

The Division employee to whom Ms. West spoke requested she send a fax to the Division for clarification. See Exhibit H. Ms. West sent a letter by fax to the Division on August 4, 2010. See Attachment to Exhibit F. Its purpose was to insure there was no confusion about the length of time for which Mainstreet Merchants had been in existence. The letter set forth Ms. West's understanding, based on her conversations with the Division's representative, that the required look-back reports would be submitted as soon as possible. Further, it demonstrated Mainstreet's good faith effort to comply with the law and disclose all activities as required.

Ms. West filed the 2010 F1 report on August 19, 2010. See Exhibit I. On October 4, 2010, the Division sent a letter to Mr. McAllister informing him that a report due August 6, 2010 was not filed until August 19, 2010. See Exhibit J. According to this letter, the report was 13 days late.

Mitigating Circumstances

We respectfully request the Commission consider the following:

- Prior to the *Broward Coalition* decision, Mainstreet filed reports with the Florida Division of Election since 2004. During the tenure of the current Treasurer, Sally West House, all reports were timely filed according to law. (We believe Mainstreet may have been subject to a fine in 2006, prior to Ms. West's tenure as Treasurer. Mainstreet records do not indicate any other concerns regarding Mainstreet's adherence to law.) Immediately following the *Broward Coalition* decision, Mainstreet filed reports with the federal government. This demonstrates Mainstreet's long-standing commitment to lawful and timely reporting of ECO activities.
- Throughout the registration process, Ms. West communicated with the Division on numerous occasions in an attempt to understand the registration process and submit the correct information. She promptly made changes as requested by the Division. Ms. West submitted a letter by fax to the Division at its request that spelled out Mainstreet's activities. This demonstrates Mainstreet's good faith effort to work with openly the Division to provide the correct information. It also demonstrates Mainstreet's good faith effort to respond promptly to clear directives from the Division.
- The ECO law was declared unconstitutional, and re-enacted one year later with substantial amendments. The Division stated that new registration information would be available on the website, and this was delayed. A new ECO handbook was not immediately available to provide guidance to potential registrants. The Division required the DS-DE 103 be submitted three different times and provided conflicting information to Ms. West. The Division also requested information from Ms. West to clarify Mainstreet's activities and history. This demonstrates there was a great deal of change and confusion regarding ECO registration following re-enactment of the law.

• According to Sec. 106.0703(7)(b), Florida Statutes, "for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day." The letter clearly states the report was due August 6, 2010 and was not submitted until August 19, 2010. This is a period of 13 days. Under the provisions of the statute, the fine would be \$6,500.00 (13 days x \$500). The imposition of fine letter issued on October 4, 2010 indicates a fine of \$12,150.00. This demonstrates the Division did not fulfill its statutory duty to promptly and correctly notify Mainstreet of its late filing and the basis for the computation of the corresponding fine. Given the clear statement by the Division that the report was 13 days late, we are confused as to how the Division arrived at the figure of \$12,150.00.

We are troubled by the duty to keep, maintain, and submit reports for the period of time during which the law was unconstitutional. We are aware Sec. 106.0703(8), Florida Statutes, requires an ECO to "electronically file the periodic reports that would have been required pursuant to this section for reportable activities that occurred since the date of the last general election." Compliance with this section would be straightforward had the statute remained in continuous effect. It is not at all clear that the law can retroactively require the submission of reports of contributions and expenditures of an entity not subject to state regulation during the period of time in which the Florida Division of Elections had no authority to enforce the ECO law and was enjoined by the Federal courts from doing so.

We respectfully assert requiring the submission of reports for the period of time in which the law was unconstitutional is an inappropriate retroactive application of the statute. To determine if a law should be applied retroactively, first one would consider if the legislature has stated a clear intent to apply the statute retroactively. *Metropolitan Dade County v. Chase Federal Housing*, 737 So.2d 494 (Fla., 1999). Absent clear legislative intent, "a law affecting substantive rights, liabilities and duties is presumed to apply prospectively." *Id.* at 499. Second, one would consider if retroactive application is constitutionally permissible. *Id*; *Florida Hospital Waterman, Inc. v. Buster*, 984 So.2d 478 (Fla., 2008). If retroactive application is merely procedural and remedial in nature, retroactive application is permissible. *McCord v. Smith*, 43 So.2d 704 (Fla., 1949). If retroactive application creates a new duty or obligation, or "attaches

new legal consequences to events completed before its enactment", retroactive application would be inappropriate. *Metro Dade County* at 503, 499.

The statute contains a duty to report all reportable activities occurring since the last general election upon registration with the Division. This language was present in both the statute as it existed prior to *Broward Coalition* and the statute as reenacted in 2010. That the law was declared unconstitutional and the Division clearly exercised no authority in this area for the intervening period between laws is significant. The 2010 iteration of the law does not specify a retroactive duty to report activities taking place while there was no constitutional statute in place. Simply restating the previous law does not address whether the legislature intended to create a retroactive duty to keep and submit reports to the Division for the period of time in which the court's opinion in *Broward Coalition* clearly forbade the Division from enforcing ECO laws. The 2010 reenactment cured constitutional infirmities in the statute for prospective application. But it would be unjust for the Division to circumvent the court's decision in *Broward Coalition* and attempt to retroactively obtain reports that it had no authority to require during that period of time.

If it is determined that the reenactment of the law with no additional clarification or guidance is deemed sufficient to establish legislative intent, the additional duties and penalties of retroactive application make such application inappropriate. Mainstreet is being required to file a report for the intervening period in which there was no constitutional law in effect. Without the guidance of a constitutional state law, it is unclear what the state reporting requirements would have been. Thus it is a new duty, a duty not imposed prior to the passage of the 2010 law. It can be argued that requiring the filing is merely remedial in nature and seeks to insure there are no gaps in reporting. However, failing to file such reports or filing them in an untimely fashion carries a stiff penalty of several thousand dollars. The levy of a sizable penalty is a significant legal consequence that also makes retroactive application inappropriate.

We respectfully assert there is no clear legislative intent to require retroactive reporting to the Division for the period of time in which there was no constitutional state law requiring the registration and reporting of ECO contributions and expenditures in place. Further, requiring the submission of reports for that period of time creates a new duty for ECOs. Failure to fulfill that

new duty carries with it significant penalty. For these reasons, we respectfully assert retroactive application of a duty to submit reports to the Division, and the fines resulting from untimely submission of those reports, for ECO activities taking place from May 22, 2009 through May 28, 2010 is inappropriate and impermissible.

Florida Mainstreet Merchants has consistently acted in good faith, making every effort to comply with both the letter of the law and the spirit of the law. We respectfully assert the present situation is the result of confusion and honest mistake.

Based on the foregoing, we provide notice of our appeal and request a hearing by personal appearance. We respectfully request the Commission to waive the fine in whole or in part based on good faith efforts to comply with the law.

DECLARATION OF SALLY WEST HOUSE IN SUPPORT OF

FLORIDA MAINSTREET MERCHANTS NOTICE OF APPEAL AND REQUEST FOR HEARING TO THE FLORIDA ELECTIONS COMMISSION

I, Sally West House, declare under penalty of perjury that the following is true:

- 1. I am a citizen of the United States, a resident of the state of Florida, and I am over the age of 18. I make this declaration in support of Florida Mainstreet Merchants' appeal; it is based on my personal knowledge of the facts stated herein.
- 2. I am the registered Treasurer of Florida Mainstreet Merchants (Mainstreet), an Electioneering Communications Organization. In this role, I file all of the reports required by the Florida Division of Elections (Division) for Mainstreet. I have served in this role since January 2008. Excluding the current situation, Mainstreet has not been subject to any fines by the Division during my tenure as Treasurer.
- 3. Prior to Broward Coalition v. Browning in 2009, I submitted all required reports for Mainstreet to the Florida Division of Elections. Subsequent to the decision, I filed the appropriate termination paperwork with the Division of Elections for Mainstreet. I then began filing reports with the Internal Revenue Service as required by federal law for Mainstreet.
- 4. I received a memo dated June 3, 2010 from the Florida Division of Elections. This memo informed me that the Governor had signed into law House Bill 131, again subjecting electioneering communications organizations to state registration and reporting.
- 5. The June 3 memo stated new registration information would be available on the Division of Elections website. This information was not immediately available on the website. As a result, Mainstreet was not able to immediately register with the Division. I received

several informal emails from the Division informing me of the delays. Once the information was available, I commenced with the registration process for Mainstreet.

- 6. It was not readily apparent to me how I should register Florida Mainstreet Merchants. I had the option of checking one of two boxes. Box One stated that the organization was formed "[a]s a newly created organization during the current calendar quarter." Box Two stated this organization was formed "[f]rom an organization existing prior to the current calendar quarter." Because we properly terminated Mainstreet in 2009, I was unsure how Mainstreet would be classified.
- 7. I asked the Division if it should be regarded as a new organization or as a pre-existing organization. I received guidance from the Division that Mainstreet should be registered as a new organization. I filed the registration papers with the Division via certified letter on July 22, 2010.
- 8. Following the submission of the registration papers, the Division called Rick McAllister, Chairperson of Mainstreet, to tell him changes to the DS-DE 103 were necessary. No written notification was given. Mr. McAllister forwarded this message to me. I was out of the office and unable to make requested changes until my return. I made the requested changes and submitted the corrected DS-DE 103 to the Division.
- 9. The Division then requested additional changes to a different section of the DS-DE 103. I made the requested changes and submitted the DS-DE 103, via hand delivery, for the third time on August 3, 2010.
- 10. I received a letter from the Division to Mainstreet on August 4, 2010. The letter was sent to Rick McAllister, Chairperson of Florida Mainstreet Merchants; I was carbon copied. The letter indicated the Application for Certification was received on August 3, 2010 and Mainstreet was now considered an active organization.
- 11. The letter raised additional questions for me about reports that were requested by the letter, so I called the Division for clarification. The gentleman I spoke with stated that

because there were so many organizations going through the re-registration process, it was acceptable to submit them in a reasonable time period. He did not specify what constituted a reasonable time period, but encouraged me to submit the reports quickly.

12. The Division employee also requested that I send a letter to the Division for clarification. I faxed the letter to the Division on August 4, 2010. The letter was intended to insure there was no confusion about the length of time that Mainstreet was in existence. Further, I wanted to demonstrate a good faith effort to comply with the law and disclose all activities as required, including reports of contributions and expenditures received by Mainstreet when there were no valid state registration or reporting requirements. After conversing with the Division employee, I did not understand that Mainstreet would be required to submit the reports within two days. At no time was I advised by the Division employee that his statement that it was acceptable to submit reports in a reasonable time meant within two days. I felt two weeks was a reasonable period of time in which to submit reports.

13. I filed the 2010 F1 and Q1 report on August 19, 2010.

14. On October 4, 2010, the Division sent a letter to Mr. McAllister informing him that the 2010 F1 report due August 6, 2010 was not filed until August 19, 2010.

15. On October 6, the Division sent a letter to Mr. McAllister informing him that the 2010 Q1 report due August 6, 2010 was not filed until August 19, 2010

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.



With the Governor signing into law House Bill 131 (now Chapter 2010-167, Laws of Florida), electioneering communication laws will again be enforced in Florida. The new laws regarding electioneering communications and electioneering communications organizations (ECOs) became effective on May 28, 2010. The chapter law can be found at: http://laws.flrules.org/.

The Division of Elections has posted a new registration form on its website to accommodate ECOs in complying with the new laws. All ECOs that meet the criteria of the new law, including any ECO that kept its registration current during the period of non-enforcement of the electioneering communications law, must submit new Forms DS-DE 6, 41, and 103 with the applicable filing officer.

The Division will post a new ECO handbook on its website as soon as it is available. We suggest that once it is available, you review the handbook for an overview of the new definition of an "electioneering communication" and the registration, reporting, and disclaimer requirements. When complete, the handbook will be posted under "Publications" at:
