Marco Zanini 1994

"Glass is magical, and so is the world that surrounds it," says Italian master Zanini. "You never know exactly how it will come out. You design it, but ultimately it depends on another man's skill." Due to the forming process, each of these vessels is unique.

From its inception in the mind of the designer to the moment it first takes shape on the glass blowing floor, a Steuben vessel is an ever-evolving work of art.








