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#### **ToCC** RULES, REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES AGREEMENT

Taste of Charles County, produced by the Rotary Club of Waldorf, will be held on Saturday, April 26, 2014 at the O'Donnell Lake. The event will be open to the public from 11:00 am -3:00pm.

#### 1. **DEFINITIONS USED HEREIN**

**Facility:** O'Donnell Lake

**Event:** SpringFest 2014, to be held April 26, 2013 (Rain or Shine)

Participant(s): Each person, organization, retailer, food & beverage vendor that has made application for space, at Taste of Charles County 2014, by executing a Food Vendor Application or a Sponsorship Agreement Form.

**RCW or Waldorf Rotary**: Rotary Club of Waldorf

ToCC: *Taste of Charles County* 

#### 2. DEADLINE FOR PARTICIPATION

All required *Taste of Charles County 2014* paperwork and payment in full must be received by Waldorf Rotary no later than Friday, April 18, 2014. Booth space will be confirmed once full payment, the signed Food Vendor Application and Menu Info, Rules & Regulations Agreement, and, if applicable, the Electricity Form have been received and approved by RCW.

Booth space for this event may be limited and will be assigned on a first come-first served basis. Participant specifically understands that – as such – there may be no more space available by the time it submits all paperwork and payment - even if all participant submissions and compliance are timely.

RCW reserves the right to accept or deny any application submitted for participation in RCW's *Taste of* Charles County in its sole and arbitrary discretion. Please note that we strive to maintain a balanced representation of industries among our *ToCC* Participants.

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#### 3. ASSIGNMENT AND USE BY OTHERS

Participant space is restricted to one organization per space, and the participant may not assign its space or permit any other person, firm or organization to use any part of such space without the express written permission of RCW.

#### 4. CANCELLATION

SpringFest 2014 and *ToCC* is a rain or shine event and no refunds, cancellations and/or returns of payments and/or authorized charges will be made due to cancellation of the Event or any portion thereof due to inclement weather or any other cause not within the control of the RCW.

#### 5. SETUP / BREAKDOWN

Participant set up time is on Saturday, April 26 from 9:00am - 10:45am. All production vehicles must be removed from parking lot by 10:45am on Saturday. Participant specifically agrees not to initiate packing and breakdown any sooner than when the Event is finished at 3:00 pm. All ToCC Participants are responsible for supplying their own tents, tables, chairs, etc. RCW will not be responsible for any damage done to any Participant materials or equipment (eg. tents, tables, chairs, appliances, food preparation equipment and supplies, etc.). Trash cans will be provided by *Evergreen Disposal* for the Event.

#### 6. CODE COMPLIANCE

*ToC*C Participants are required to adhere to all laws and provisions established by the State of Maryland, Charles County (including the Charles County Health Department, the Charles County Fire and Rescue Department, Office of the Fire Marshal, etc.), and all other federal, state and local laws, rules and regulations applicable to Participant and its involvement in the *Taste of Charles County 2014*.

#### 7. CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

All *ToCC Participants* are required to provide a certificate of general liability insurance listing the Rotary Club of Waldorf as additionally insured.

#### 8. SALES TAX

All exhibitors/*ToCC Participants* acknowledge their sole responsibility to comply with all federal, state and local tax ordinances.

#### 9. FOOD VENDOR MENU SELECTION & BEVERAGES

There are no restrictions on the cuisine that you can feature at this event, however, selections should be coordinated with the Taste of Charles County Committee to avoid duplication. ALL BEVERAGES WILL BE SOLD EXCLUSIVELY BY RCW through identified beverage booths. All food vendors must submit the Menu Selection Form with its complete application package.

#### 10. TICKET SALES, PROCEDURES AND MEETING FOR ToCC PARTICIPANTS

RCW will handle all cash transactions for *Taste of Charles County 2014*. No cash transactions are allowed on premises, other than at designated SpringFest 2014 Ticket Booths. Attendees will exchange *SpringFest* Tickets for Samples at posted rates (as are consistent with Menu Form). SpringFest 2014 tickets are valued at \$1 each.

ToCC Participants will receive 60% of the value of the tickets collected at its respective booth (based on face value of \$1 each). RCW will endeavor to provide cash disbursements on event day, but no later than 3 calendar days following the event.

Cash transactions are not permitted anywhere on the premises during this event, outside of the official *Taste of Charles County* Ticket Booths.

All beverage sales will be confined to the SpringFest Beverage Booths located throughout the event site. No other beverage sales will be permitted.

#### 11. EVENT CLEAN UP

Food vendor participant will not be allowed to dump grease or any other debris on the premises (street, storm drain, grassy areas – nowhere!) at any time. Participant must make arrangements to dispose of any and all materials and trash brought onto or generated on the premises.

Any Participant that fails to clean up their individual booth, make any applicable repairs, and/or abide with the rules and regulations stated herein, will forfeit the opportunity to participate in next year's event and shall be fully and solely liable for the cost incurred in any such clean-up and/or repairs. In cases where cleanup and/or damage repair is required, RCW may withhold payment of Participant's share of booth sales. Participant shall further pay any remaining balance due for such clean-up and/or repair costs within ten days of the event. Each *ToCC Participant* authorizes RCW to issue a charge against its credit card for any cleanup and/or damage repair expense for which RCW is not fully compensated by Participant's share of booth sales, if any, to which it otherwise may have been entitled. Any items left by the participant will be deemed as trash and disposed of appropriately and immediately.



#### **BOOTH PARTICIPATION RESTRICTIONS** 12.

Participants are encouraged to market their business to attendees by distributing promotional materials. Balloons may be used for display purposes, but may not be distributed to event attendees. All balloons must be popped and discarded at the end of the event.

*ToCC Participants* may not sell or raffle any items during the event unless approved in advance by RCW.

No goods or services, including tickets, or promotions of any kind may be held for sale or sold by *ToCC* Participants without prior written approval from RCW.

#### **13. Cooking and Electricity**

Users of charcoal and/or butane/propane grills is allowed, however the *ToCC Participant* is solely responsible for compliance with all regulatory and safety requirements.

Any *ToCC Participant* utilizing a grill during this event must also have a fire extinguisher (minimum rating: 2A20BC) available within the designated booth.

Onsite electric service may be limited on event day unless requested in advance. See Electric Need Form below.

#### 14. Various

SpringFest does not guarantee exclusivity. There may be other vendors selling similar food items, however we work very hard to limit this.

SpringFest committee will determine space location.

Neither RCW nor the SpringFest committee is responsible for the success of the ToCC Participant.





#### What is Rotary?
