Guidance Notes - Application for Birth Certificate Information Before Adoption

This form should be completed by the adopted person, who must be 18 or over, who wishes to apply for their original birth details which you can then use, if you so wish, to apply for a copy of your original birth registration. We recommend that you read all of the guidance notes before completing the form.

The completed form should be posted to the Registrar General at the **General Register Office**, **Adoptions**, **Room C202**, **Smedley Hydro**, **Trafalgar Road**, **Southport**, **Merseyside PR8 2HH**.

Please allow 20 working days from receipt of the application at the GRO for the application to be processed. <u>Section 1 - Adoption Details -</u> This section is mandatory

- 1.1 Surname This is the surname you were given on adoption.
- 1.2 Forename This is the forename(s) given to you on adoption.
- 1.3 Date of Birth This is the date you were born on.
- 1.4 Date of Adoption This is the date on which you were adopted if known.
- 1.5 Adoptive Mother/Parent The forename(s) and surname of your adoptive mother/parent.
- 1.6 Adoptive Father/Parent The forename(s) and surname of your adoptive father/parent.

Section 2 - Original Birth Details (if known)

- 2.1 Surname This is your surname before adoption.
- 2.2 Forenames The name(s) you were known by before adoption.
- 2.3 Birth Mother The person who gave birth to you.
- 2.4 Birth Father The father named on your original birth entry.

2.5 County and/or Country of Birth - The county in England or Wales or country you were born in.

Section 3 - Adopted before 12 November 1975

3.1 You may be able to see an adoption advisor in the country in which you live. Alternatively, if you intend to vist the UK we will be able to advise you on the options available to you.

Section 4 - Adopted after 12 November 1975

- 4.1 After a change in legislation if adopted after 12 November 1975 you are not required to see an adoption advisor.
- 4.2 Please tick the appropriate box.

<u>Section 5 - Adopted after 12th</u> <u>November 1975</u>

5.1 Proof of your current address is required. You should provide an original of a current utility bill, current bank statement or documentation from another government department when returning this application form. We will return the document to you.

Section 6 - Applicant's Details

- 6.1 Surname The surname you are currently known by now.

- 6.3 Address This is where you currently live.
