**Hidden Disabilities** - Explore ways to support girls with autism, ADHD, and other "hidden" disabilities, best practices on how to make your unique and diverse troop a successful one for all of your girls.

**SciGirls** - SciGirls is a national program that engages girls in fun science activities. This session will share tips and tools for how to engage girls in science and how to form a SciGirls club.
