

Dog Obedience Training

If any of these issues are true for your dog, then it is time for obedience training. Classes are offered for all dogs ages 3 months and older. Entire families are welcome to attend. Vaccination record required. Classes are educational and FUN!

Basic Training: We teach you techniques to get your dog to be a polite and well behaved dog.
