All students being named to *Who's Who at UTSA* will receive a special *Who's Who at UTSA* certificate.

Students' that are being named to Who's Who at UTSA is an exclusive honor. Students will have demonstrated outstanding accomplishments in the areas of scholarship, leadership, participation in co-curricular and academic activities, and service to the University and local community.

The *Who's Who* national program was started in 1934 for the purpose of recognizing and honoring students who demonstrate outstanding achievement during their collegiate careers. Today more than 2,300 colleges and universities participate annually.

Any previous junior, senior, or graduate students who have been previously selected to Who's Who Among Students in American Universities & College® will not be selected in 2010-2011 so that we may optimize this program for many qualified students. The university will verify all academic and disciplinary standing for all nominees prior to selection to Who's Who.
