Congratulations again on your acceptance into the IMSA Class of 2015. As was indicated in your acceptance letter, Excel is a three-week summer experience for students who have been identified through the application and placement testing process. Excel students are fully qualified for admission but are identified as needing a review of key concepts, additional skills and/or experiences in order to be prepared to do well at IMSA.

You have been identified to attend Excel this July. Your admission to IMSA in August is dependent upon your successful completion of the Excel program, and you MUST ATTEND THE ENTIRE PROGRAM. There are no exceptions to this requirement.

Successful completion is determined when students demonstrate progress in developing necessary academic and residential skills, working collaboratively with others, problem solving in new contexts, completing assignments and seeking appropriate help from other students and staff.

The Excel program begins on Sunday, July 8th and continues through Friday, July 27<sup>rd</sup>.

Excel Students are required to stay on campus the first weekend, July 13-15. Students have the option of going home during the second weekend after 4:00 p.m. Friday the 20<sup>th</sup>, returning by 6:30 p.m. on Sunday the 22<sup>nd</sup>. **There is no tuition or room and board fee for the Excel program.**
