To be considered for a scholarship, students must submit an application for admission to Lake Land College and be officially enrolled for a minimum of 12 semester hours, or be classified to be full-time by program of study. Students are strongly encouraged to complete a Free Application for Federal/Student Aid (FAFSA). Contact the office of Financial Aid to apply for Federal Financial Aid. **Applications MUST be fully completed. Any fields left incomplete may result in your application being rejected.**
