

2013 Red Cross Certification for Wilderness and Remote First Aid Course

Open to all Scouters

What: Red Cross training and certification for Scouters needing Wilderness and Remote First Aid skills and certification for High Adventure Trips. This course meets the BSA requirement for at least one current trained leader in Wilderness First Aid on High Adventure Treks. The course requires that participants have current CPR/AED skills prior to taking the course. ARC, AHA or similar evidence of recent training is a prerequisite.

Who: Any Scout leader or mature youth at least 14 years old needing Wilderness First Aid skills.

This course will provide participants a foundation in first aid principles and skills to be able to respond to emergencies and give care in areas that do not have immediate medical services (EMS) response.

The course is approximately 16 hours long (in 4 four sessions) and requires participants to complete all sessions. Participants will be required to apply hands on skills that will be covered in class. The course fee includes a useful American Red Cross workbook and reference cards. Participants should wear comfortable clothing that enables them to perform first aid skills including focused assessments of simulated injuries.

The course will be limited to a maximum of 30 participants. All sessions must be attended to complete the course and become certified. Certification is for 2 years. Questions on recertification should be directed to Don Ray at 734-455-7214 or email: djray@comcast.net
