I first came to the YMCA of the Rockies in 1974 as a seasonal employee for two summers and a winter. Even after going away to start a career and a family, I never quite left the place. Like many others, my family and I returned almost every year to vacation at the Y. During her college years my daughter, Susan, worked on the staff. Then 35 years later my wife, Janet, and I returned to work as volunteers.

My job as "planned giving director" is simply to discover folks who love the Y of the Rockies and might consider including the Y in their will or estate plan. Currently there are 67 families who have told the Y that they have already done that as a way of helping to insure the Y's presence for future generations. Collectively, we are known as the Spirit Society for the YMCA of the Rockies.

Two of the simplest ways to join the Spirit Society are to include the Y in your will or as a partial beneficiary to an IRA or other retirement plan. Another possibility is to purchase a "charitable gift annuity" which has immediate benefits for you in terms of a guaranteed income for life. There are others as well. In some cases there may be tax advantages to you or your heirs, depending on the type of gift you choose to make.

Janet and I have joined the Spirit Society because the Y of the Rockies has been an important part of our lives for nearly 40 years. It's an honor for me to serve as the custodian for the Spirit Society and I'd be happy to visit with you about your own involvement.
