If you feel like the name you registered your license under does not give an accurate description of the type of business you have then come in and do a name change. This is provided at no extra cost. On the back page of this newsletter a current list has been provided and if you need more information please call the city office and we can provide you a contact phone number so you can start shopping more in our own city. Thank you to all the businesses in town that make the City of St. Anthony a wonderful place to live.

The City of St. Anthony has been working with Sheriff Len Humphries and the Fremont County Sheriff's Office to come



up with a solution for contacting citizens during emergencies, including letting them know about snow plowing efforts in town or possible emergency notices. Fremont County has already contracted with Emergency Communications Network to license its CodeRED high-speed notification solution. The CodeRED system gives officials the ability to quickly deliver messages to targeted areas

or the entire county. Sheriff Len Humphries says the systems are only as good as the telephone number database supporting them. "If your phone number is not in the database, you will not be called." One of the reasons the CodeRED system was selected is it gives individuals and businesses the ability to add their own phone numbers directly into the system's database. To sign up for the CodeRED services go to the Fremont County Web site: www.co.fremont.idaho.id.us and click on the CodeRED trademark towards the bottom of the page. "No one should automatically assume his or her phone number is included," Humphries says, urging all individuals and businesses to register. Required information includes first and last name, street address (physical address, no P.O. boxes), city, state, zip code, and primary phone number. Additional phone numbers can be entered as well. All businesses should register, as well as all individuals who have unlisted phone numbers, who have changed their phone number or address within the past year, and those who use a cellular phone or VoIP phone as their primary number. Humphries says, "CodeRED allows geographically based delivery, which means street addresses are required to ensure emergency notification calls are received by the proper individuals in a given situation. The system works for cell phones too, but we need to have an associated street address to provide relevant messages. CodeRED gives those who want to be included an easy and secure method for inputting information. The data collected will only be used for emergency notification purposes." Humphries cautions users who log on to the web site to be patient and fill out all the required fields. They should pay close attention to the map that appears when a street address is entered to make sure the location has been pinpointed accurately. Users can create an account so that they may update their information later. Anyone who does not have Internet access, who would like to register, should call the Sheriff's Office at 208-624-4482. City of St. Anthony Refinances Water and Sewer Bonds!

You may have already read in the paper about the significant savings on the recent refunding or refinancing of the water and sewer bonds. How much did the city save by doing this? They saved a total Net Present Value of \$661,550.43. Each year the city will experience a portion of this savings which will be applied towards water and sewer operations. This year alone the city will save a combined \$47,982.54 and next year it will be \$67,555.55. The transaction was something the city has been working on for some time and in prior years didn't make sense until interest rates reached all-time lows. The city then, in co-operation with the Idaho Bond Bank Authority, other cities and Zion's Bank Public Finance finally completed a transaction in mid-December 2012 to refund the existing bonds. Idaho residents approved a constitutional amendment in 2000 creating the bond bank, which enables cities like ours to pool smaller bond issues into a single, large issue allowing for more favorable rates and terms. This is something we couldn't do on our own. This is a very exciting time for us and will enable the city to do some needed upgrades to our water and sewer systems without having to make even larger increases to our customers.
