GREAT PRIZES!

The criteria for judging will be based on the following:

- A) Size: The banner cannot be larger than 30" x 36", whether it is vertical or horizontal.
- B) Theme: The banner must incorporate this year's theme:
"Catch the Wave"
- C) County Name: must be present on the banner.
- D) The banner must be supported by vertical poles on each side. These poles must be minimum length of the banner, but not to exceed 5 feet tall. *(Necessary for Displaying and Judging)*

The banner must meet the A-D criteria to be considered further for judging. Judges will use a 1-5 scale to rate the following:

- E) Overall theme relation
- F) Creativity
- G) Artistic design
- H) Visual effect
- I) Professional appearance
