How long have I been running?: 2 years

<u>How I got started</u>: At the end of the 2004 Middle School Track season, my 7th grade year, I didn't stop running. At the time I was unaware of what I was getting into, but my brother put running into perspective for me. Phillip, my brother, is the reason I run. He made state 3 consecutive years in High School, so I knew I was with a good runner. Without him, I would be nowhere near the sport of running. As the summer approached, I was firmly thinking of sleeping until 12:00, and being lazy, but my brother made me do otherwise. Every morning, I got up at 6:00 am and ran. This was new to me as you might imagine, but I loved it. Since then, I've never stopped running.

My running goals: Right now I don't truly know what times I'll accomplish because I've only been running for 2 years, but here are some of my future goals: 1) Win state in cross country and track(2-mile) 2) Run 15:00 for 5k 3) Go to college on a running scholarship

My favorite Race: My favorite race is the Boo Run in downtown Flowery Branch. Not only is this the place where I set my PR, but almost everyone I know who runs shows up.
