 - Lived on a college campus for at least 2 semesters (including the Spring 2014 semester)
 - Be a full time Flagler College student
- ❖ After the workshop on April 6th the Office of Residence Life will contact the candidates through campus email to invite them to an interview with administration.
- ❖ Interview sign ups will be in the Student Services Office on Monday, April 7, 2014 from 8:00 am-4:30 pm.
- ❖ You must attend the workshop and the interview to be eligible to be hired.
