

Jeff has represented many individuals with a wide variety of animal welfare legal issues. He has also represented a number of animal welfare organizations, including HSUS, the Animal Legal Defense Fund and humane societies in Allen, Ashland, Auglaize, Clark, Columbiana, Cuyahoga, Franklin, Fulton, Geauga, Harrison, Hocking, Holmes, Jackson, Jefferson, Lake, Logan, Lorain, Lucas, Medina, Miami, Montgomery, Morrow, Pike, Portage, Summit, Wayne, Wood and Wyandot Counties.

Jeff has served as special prosecutor for animal cruelty cases in over a dozen courts in Ohio for the past 18 years. He has conducted humane officer training for the Ohio Humane Agents Association and Ohio Federated Humane Societies, and has conducted seminars on animal cruelty law for the Ohio Veterinary Medical Association, Ohio State University, Ohio Dog Warden's Association, and the Montana Veterinary Medical Association. Jeff is also an adjunct professor teaching the Animal Law course at Case Western University Law School.

Jeff helped to draft S.B. 221, the first significant change in Ohio's animal cruelty law in over a hundred years. Jeff and his wife, Marjorie, live in Medina County with their 4 sons along with 5 dogs, 5 cats, 6 horses, chickens, fish and occasional foster animals.

I-75 Traveling South Toward Dayton

Option 1

- Take the Third Street exit into downtown, following the signs to Sinclair Community College.
- Travel east on W. Third Street until you reach the intersection of Ludlow Street.
- Turn right onto Ludlow Street, staying in the right lane of traffic.
- After passing through the Fifth Street intersection look for the entrance to Court Street on the right (it has the appearance of an alley).
- Turn right onto Court Street.
- Entrance to Building 19's controlled parking lot is located off Court Street. Parking is \$2 all day for non-students.
- Building 19 is located at Court and Wilkinson streets. (Address is 214 S. Wilkinson Street, Dayton, OH 45402)

Option 2

•

- Continue past the Third Street exit.
- Take exit 51, the Edwin C. Moses Blvd. exit.
- Turn left at bottom of exit, traveling underneath the highway overpass
- Continue on Edwin C. Moses Blvd past the UD Arena complex and Welcome Stadium.
- Continue on Edwin C. Moses to the third traffic light (you will pass through the Stewart Street and Washington Street intersections)
- At the third traffic light (Germantown Street) you will see Sinclair Community College's Building 20 on the right corner of the intersection.
- Turn right at this intersection and travel over the bridge towards downtown Dayton.
- As you travel over the bridge Germantown Street merges into W. Fifth Street. Stay on W. 5th Street.
 - After passing through several traffic light

intersections (Mead, Perry and Wilkinson Street intersections) you will come to Ludlow Street.

- Turn right onto Ludlow Street, staying in the right lane of traffic.
- Look for the entrance to Court Street on the right (it has the appearance of an alley).
- Turn right onto Court Street.
- Entrance to Building 19's controlled parking lot is located off Court Street.
 Parking is \$2 all day for nonstudents.
- Building 19 is located at Court and Wilkinson streets. (Address is 214 S. Wilkinson Street, Dayton, OH 45402)

I-75 Traveling North Toward Dayton

Option 1

- Take exit 51, the Edwin C. Moses Blvd. exit.
- Turn right at bottom of exit.
- Continue on Edwin C. Moses Blvd. past the UD Arena complex and Welcome Stadium.
- Continue on Edwin C. Moses to the third traffic light (you will pass through the Stewart Street and Washington Street intersections)
- At the third traffic light (Germantown Street) you will see Sinclair Community College's Building 20 on the right corner of the intersection.
- Turn right at this intersection and travel over the bridge towards downtown Dayton.
- As you travel over the bridge Germantown Street merges into
 W. Fifth Street. Stay on W. Fifth Street.
- After several traffic light intersections (passing through Mead, Perry and Wilkinson Street intersections) you will come to Ludlow Street. Turn right onto Ludlow Street and stay in the far right lane of travel.
- After 1/2 block turn right onto Court Street

Driving Directions

(it has the appearance of an alley).

- Entrance to Building 19's controlled parking lot is located on Court Street. Parking is \$2 all day for nonstudents.
- Building 19 is located at Court and Wilkinson streets. (Address is 214 S. Wilkinson Street, Dayton, OH 45402)

Option 2

- Continue northbound I-75 to the Third Street exit.
- Exit highway at Third Street exit, continue east on Third Street into downtown Dayton.
- Stay eastbound on Third Street until reaching the intersection of Ludlow Street (4th traffic signal after exiting highway.)
- Turn right onto Ludlow Street, staying in the right lane of traffic.
- After passing through the Fifth Street intersection look for the entrance to Court Street on the right (it has the appearance of an alley).
- Turn right onto Court Street.
- Entrance to the Building 19's controlled parking lot is located off Court Street. Parking is \$2 all day for nonstudents.
- Building 19 is located at Court and Wilkinson streets. (Address is 214 S. Wilkinson Street, Dayton, OH 45402)

US 35 Traveling East Toward Dayton

- Merge onto northbound I-75
- Almost immediately take the Third Street exit and continue eastbound on Third Street until reaching the intersection of Ludlow Street (4th traffic signal after exiting highway.)
- Turn right onto Ludlow Street, staying in the right lane of traffic.
- After passing through the Fifth Street intersection look for the entrance to Court Street on the right (it has the appearance of an alley).
- Turn right onto Court Street.
- Entrance to the Building 19's controlled parking lot is located off Court Street. Parking is \$2 all day for nonstudents.
- Building 19 is located at Court and Wilkinson streets. (Address is 214 S. Wilkinson Street, Dayton, OH 45402)

US 35 Traveling West Toward Dayton

Option 1

- Exit 35 at the Jefferson Street exit (same exit for the Dragon's Baseball Stadium)
- Travel north on Jefferson to Fifth Street. (If you miss Jefferson, take Patterson north to Fifth Street, or any other northbound street to Fifth Street.)
- Turn left on Fifth Street, traveling westbound.
- At Ludlow Street turn left (Ludlow is one-way, southbound, one block west of Main Street).
 Immediately move into the far right travel lane.
- Look for the entrance to Court Street on the right (it has the appearance of an alley).
- Turn right onto Court Street.
- Entrance to Building 19's controlled parking lot is located off Court Street. Parking is \$2 all day for nonstudents.
- Building 19 is located at Court and Wilkinson streets. (Address is 214 S. Wilkinson Street, Dayton, OH 45402)

Option 2

- Merge onto northbound I-75
- Almost immediately take the Third Street exit and continue eastbound on Third Street until reaching the intersection of Ludlow Street (4th traffic signal after exiting highway.)
- Turn right onto Ludlow Street, staying in the right lane of traffic.
- After passing through the Fifth Street intersection look for the entrance to Court Street on the right (it has the appearance of an alley).
- Turn right onto Court Street.
- Entrance to the Building 19's controlled parking lot is located off Court Street. Parking is \$2 all day for nonstudents.
- Building 19 is located at Court and Wilkinson streets. (Address is 214 S. Wilkinson Street, Dayton, OH 45402)
