Tour Indicators/Symbols

Level 1:	Involves walking over relatively level terrain, possibly some cobblestone, gravel or a few steps. Comfortable shoes are recommended.

Caves & Mangroves Exploration

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 3, Family Recommended

From the pier, board a speedboat and after a safety briefing, begin an ecological experience. Known for having one of the lushest rainforests and mangrove reserves in the Caribbean, Los Haitises National Park is a beautiful sanctuary. You'll circle the small cay known as Bird Island as your guide explains the importance of the many migratory and indigenous birds that inhabit the island. Your Captain will dock the boat at an area of captivating caves and your guide will provide information on the people that inhabited these caves and the islands. Cave drawings representing the gods and the daily life of the Taino Indians will give you a glimpse into the life of these ancient people. You'll also see beautiful stalagmites and stalactites which have formed over centuries.

Note: Participants must be able to navigate on uneven surfaces. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women. Wear comfortable clothing, closed-toe footwear or Teva®-type sandals.

Cayo Levantado Beach Escape

Approximate Duration: 5 hours

Level 1, Family Recommended

Be whisked away to a private island for a day of fun. Leave your ship by boat and head to the island of Cayo Levantado. Here, you are on your own to explore the gentle hills, swim in the turquoise sea or relax on the

Discover Samana

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Family Recommended

Board your transportation for a sightseeing tour of Samana city. Your first stop will be at La Churcha, an old building built in England to house the freed North American congregation in the 1860s. Next, you'll head to a small whale museum where experts will point out some of the mysteries of the humpback whale. Leaving Samana town behind, and on your way to Las Terrenas village, you'll have a photo opportunity of the highest peak situated between Las Terrenas and Samana. Here you'll witness spectacular views of the north coast of Samana. Las Terrenas is a village that lives off the tourism business and where you can find enjoyment at all times on their beaches, and in the streets, hotels, bars, discos and restaurants serving exquisite plates and fresh seafood. Enjoy shopping for a variety of arts and crafts, many of them being unique handmade items that can be difficult to find elsewhere in the Dominican Republic.

Note: Many of the shops at Las Terrenas are closed on Sundays. We recommend you wear comfortable walking shoes.

Self Drive 4 x 4 Adventure

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 3, Age Requirements

Explore the beauty of Samana by Jeep. Discover off-road wonders and the tropical diversity of Samana as you take turns driving your own 4x4 Jeep. You'll enjoy passing by crystal-clear rivers and beautiful views of the peninsula's flora and fauna. Your first stop will be at a typical Dominican farm featuring native fruits, coconut, coffee and chocolate. Your guide will explain how these items are grown, harvested and prepared for market. You'll even have the opportunity to sample many of the fruits and the fantastic coffee. You'll then make the scenic and relaxing return to Samana pier where you can enjoy shopping in town.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age, 18 years of age to drive and must provide a valid driver's license. All Jeeps are manual transmission and accommodate 4 per vehicle. There are sharp curves and bumpy roads. The tour also includes an approximately 20-minute walk on uneven, sometimes muddy and slippery surfaces. Not recommended for pregnant women or those with back or neck injuries. Drivers may rotate during this tour. There is no swimming at El Valle Beach.

Caves & Mangroves Exploration & Beach Escape

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 3, Age Requirements, Family Recommended

Departing from the pier you'll cross the bay by open-air speedboat to Los Haitises National Park. Stop to circle the small Birds Kay which provides a home and nesting site for 110 species of birds including the brown pelican and magnificent frigate bird. Afterwards, sail to the mangroves and discover the impressive roots covered by shells and caves with stalagmites and stalactites. Another major attraction of the park is its extensive cave system, and you'll visit the La Arena and La Linea Caves. If time permits enjoy a dip in the fresh water that flow through this reserve.

Note: Participants must be at least 4 years of age and able to navigate on uneven surfaces. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women. Wear your swimsuit and comfortable clothing, closed-toe footwear or Teva®-type sandals. Credit card or cash is required at the beach for water sport rentals and BBQ. Bring a towel.

Bike, Hike & Kayak

Approximate Duration: 4 ½ hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

At the pier, you'll board open-air safari truck on unpaved roads for a scenic, coastal ride to the marble mines area. Then, mount your bike and ride beside a 300-foot-high cliff that stretches for miles. Your guide brings to life the story of this abandoned mine. Then, leave your bike at the marble mines and take a walk among the unique flora at the Boca Del Diablo blow hole. Next, board your transportation and head for La Playita Beach to kayak in the turquoise waters or relax under the Caribbean sun before boarding the safari truck and returning to the pier. This is a rugged outing with amazing sights.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age, weigh no more than 250 lbs. and in good physical condition. This tour is not recommended for those with back or leg problems.

Mangrove Exploration by Kayak

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age Requirements

Known for having one the lushest rainforests and mangrove reserves in the Caribbean, Los Haitises National Park is a spectacular sanctuary. You'll circle in a speedboat around the beautiful islands of Los Haitises and visit one of the caves. Cave drawings representing the gods and the daily life of the Taino Indians gives you a glimpse into the life of these ancient people. After the cave visit, begin your kayak adventure in the hidden river canals of the mangrove forest.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age and must be able to navigate slightly uneven surfaces. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women.

Catamaran Sail & Beach Escape

Approximate Duration: 3 ¼ hours

Level 2, Age Requirements, Family Recommended

This 46-foot catamaran takes you on a leisurely trip around Samana Bay for approximately two hours. Then, head to Cayo Levantado, the private island, to enjoy the white-sand beach and to relax. There are quaint little shops to explore, time to swim or just stroll for two hours. Then, you'll return to your ship via regular tender service.

Note: Participants must be at least 2 years of age. At the beach, a barbeque and a tropical lunch is available at

Safari Adventure

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age Requirements

Board a specially equipped, open-air truck safari vehicle and make your way to an unpaved road that takes you through small, colorful villages. Your guide provides information on Dominican life and culture as well as pointing out areas of interest. Your first stop will be a typical Dominican farm featuring native fruits, coconut, coffee and chocolate. Then travel to El Valle Beach, a white-sand beach fringed with palm trees. Reboard your safari vehicle for the trip to La Cascada El Valle, a beautiful waterfall. From the falls take the Loma de la Pina Trail through lush vegetation before returning to the Samana Pier.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age. Not recommended for people who have back or leg problems. There is no swimming at El Valle Beach.

Sea Lion Encounter

Approximate Duration: 3 ½ hours

Level 1, Age Requirements, Family Recommended

Leave your ship by boat to the small island of Cayo Levantado where you'll be greeted by your guide and receive a complimentary welcome drink. Then you'll be guided to the sea lion pool to meet your playful hosts and receive a briefing about the origins, lifestyles, eating habits and abilities of these interesting mammals. The briefing will end with you being able to feed the sea lions. Next you are off to the beach where you will have the chance to go swimming with the sea lions in the open ocean to witness their swimming skills and you'll be able to touch and caress them. The interaction ends at the beach where you'll receive a kiss from the sea lions. The remainder of your time is at leisure on the beautiful island of Cayo Levantado.

Note: Participants must be at least 6 years of age. Actual time with the sea lions is approximately 30 minutes. Order of tour may be reversed with beach time first. Open water swimming is limited to good weather conditions and other variables. If it's not possible to perform in the ocean then the interaction will be limited to the sea lion pool area. At the beach, a barbeque and a tropical lunch is available at an additional charge. Credit card or cash is required for water sport rentals. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

Retreat to Grand Paradise Resort

Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Level 1, Meal, Family Recommended, Ultimate Touring

Depart from the tender pier ashore for a drive to the Grand Paradise Resort Samana. There you'll have time to enjoy the facilities of the resort, use the various pools. A buffet lunch is included along with national alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks.

Note: Drive time to the resort is approximately one hour. No hotel room or beach towels are included in the package. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

Sail, Snorkel & Cayena Del Mar Beach

Approximate Duration: 3 ¾ hours

Level 2, Age Requirements, Family Recommended

Sail the blue waters of Samana Bay aboard your comfortable catamaran. You'll board the catamaran and then set sail with the Caribbean breeze and stunning scenery. You'll drop anchor at Cayo Farola and snorkel among tropical fish and the coral reef. Then make the short sail to Cayena Del Mar, where you may use the fresh water showers, relax on a beach chair or under a coconut tree, play a game of volleyball or browse the gift shop. Beverages and a full menu are available at an additional charge.

Note: Participants must be at least 5 years of age and able to swim. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel. Not recommended for people who have respiratory problems. All participants must wear snorkel vests while in the water.

Mini Speedboat Adventure

Approximate Duration: 2 ¾ hours

Level 2, Age & Weight Requirements

This tour not only satisfies your need for speed but also provides a thrilling way to experience and learn about Samana and the Dominican Republic. You'll be greeted ship-side by your boat crew who will take you to the briefing center, located about 5-10 minutes from your ship. Once at the center pier, you'll be provided with important safety information as well as instructions on the safe operation of your two-man speedboat. You'll then board your boat and take a few practice spins in the bay before following your guide, caravan-style, off across the water! Make stops along the way to watch pelicans swoop for breakfast or lunch and see the many varieties of birds on Bird Island. You'll also hear the story of Arrow Island as well as learn about the battle with the Spaniards. Your group will then make a stop at a sandbar located in a very scenic area. Here you can walk out on the sandbar or take a dip in the blue waters. Reboard your boat and head towards the harbor passing under a historic bridge before returning to your start point. You'll have time to relax on the beach or browse the gift shop before boarding the transfer boat for the return to your ship.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age, weigh no more than 250 lbs. and be at least 18 years of age to drive and provide a valid driver's license. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

Journey to Playa Rincon

Approximate Duration: 5 ¼ hours

Level 2, Age Requirements, Family Recommended

Join us for an off-the-beaten path adventure. Board your safari-type vehicle for an around the peninsula of Samana. Along the way your guide will share interesting information regarding the history and culture of the Dominican Republic. You'll stop at a typical Dominican farm where you'll have the opportunity to see how local fruits grow, taste tropical fruits and enjoy the beautiful scenery. You'll have the opportunity to take photos before returning to your transport for the off-road drive to magnificent, secluded Playa Rincon. Along the way, stop at Rubi's El Rincon beach restaurant famous for their grilled lobster. You may use the restroom facilities and if you wish, order food and specialty beverages (not included). You may use the restroom facilities and if you wish, order food and specialty beverages (not included) that will be served. Playa Rincon has won praise from top travel magazines as one of the world's best beaches. Located at the base of 2,000-foot mountains, Rincon offers nearly three miles of uninterrupted white sand and lush palm groves as well as a fresh-water area lined with mangroves. Upon arrival you'll be offered a complimentary beverage as well as a light fruit salad. You are then free to relax, swim or explore. After your time at Playa Rincon, you'll re-board your transport for the return to the port.

Note: Participants must be at least 5 years of age. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel, sunscreen, sunglasses and cash for purchases. We recommend you wear sensible clothing and closed-toe shoes or sport-type sandals. The driving portion of this tour is mostly 'off-road' type conditions. Roads are very bumpy with holes. There are limited beach chairs and some water toys such as kayaks available for rent at Playa Rincon.

Waterfall Hike

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age Requirements

Upon arrival your guide will provide you with important safety information before starting off along the trail. You'll soon discover Samana in all its natural beauty and diversity. Stops are made along the way as your guide points out areas of interest. Arrive at an area hidden from view of the path that opens to a beautiful cascade which falls to a clear, natural pool. Located in a secluded area, the falls are pristine and visited only by a lucky few. You'll have plenty of time to relax with a cool beverage and swim in the pool of fresh, mountain water before making the return along a path to your waiting transport. A short stop at a ranch house will be made where you may use the restrooms or purchase a beverage before returning to your ship's tender port.

Note: Participants must be at least 12 years of age and must be able to navigate uneven surfaces. Wear comfortable clothing, closed-toe footwear or Teva®-type sandals. Trail is muddy, you'll get dirty. Please dress appropriately. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

Tortola, British Virgin Islands

Coast to Coast Scenic Drive

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 1, Family Recommended

This scenic drive is designed for those interested in seeing most of the island while seated for most of the excursion. You'll board an open-sided bus, county deluxe bus or mini van as your driver/guide welcomes you to the island. Some places seen en route are the Administration Complex, Sunny Caribbe Art Gallery, various banks, communities, beaches and schools. You'll also enjoy a stop at Cane Garden Bay. This tour includes two separate islands – Beef Island and Tortola, and photo stops are made along the way.

Approximate Duration: 4 ½ hours

Level 1, Meal, Age Requirements, Family Recommended

Catamaran Cruise

Approximate Duration: 4 hours

Level 2, Age Requirements, Family Recommended

Take a leisurely cruise along the south coast of the British Virgin Islands and enjoy breathtaking scenery. Moving smoothly through the crystal waters of the Caribbean Sea you'll view some of the other Virgin Islands such as Peter, Salt, and Cooper before your snorkeling experience. You'll see dramatic coral formations, an abundance of brightly colored tropical fish and on occasion a sea turtle or graceful ray. Your excursion then continues to a beautiful beach for swimming. On your return sail, relax on the deck as you enjoy a complimentary fruit punch.

Note: Participants must be at least 2 years of age, able to get in and out of the water and must know how to swim. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

Approximate Duration: 3 hours

Level 1, Family Recommended

Board an open-air safari bus for a scenic island tour of beautiful Tortola. Your tour takes you up Fort Hill along the Ridge Road, passing the local villages of Long Trench and Fahie Hill. As you descend Ross Path to beautiful Cane Garden Bay, several stops are made for photo opportunities. Here, you can swim in the crystal-clear water and relax on the white-sand beach. After your swim, the tour continues along the north shore and over Zion Hill for a scenic drive along the Sir Francis Drake Highway.

Note: Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel.

Dolphin Encounter

Approximate Duration: 2 hours

Level 2, Age Requirements, Family Recommended

After check-in and a brief orientation, taxis will pick you up for a short transfer to the Prospect Reef Facility. You'll descend a set of stairs into the beautiful Caribbean Sea on a submerged platform in waist-deep water, and have the chance to interact with the dolphins, including the swim-by and a kiss for a wonderful photo opportunity. The fast swim allows the dolphin to demonstrate their incredible speed and power, and you'll see several other behaviors designed to educate and fascinate you as you share an approximately 30-minute visit with these beautiful marine mammals. After the encounter, you'll be able to view the photos and video that was taken during the program.

Note: Participants must be at least 4 years of age. You'll enter the water and stand on a submerged platform (4 feet in depth) while the dolphin interacts at the command of the trainers. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel. Not recommended for pregnant women or those who suspect they are pregnant.

Dolphin Swim

Approximate Duration: 2 hours

Level 2, Age Requirements, Family Recommended

Travel through Road Town in a tour bus to the Dolphin Lagoon at Prospect Reef Resort. An approximately 30-minute introductory talk about the dolphins and procedures is given before you join the dolphin trainer's poolside to receive your life vests. Then, enter the water and interact with the dolphins as they go through their 20-to 30-minute swim session.

Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age. You'll enter the water to stand on the submerged platform (4 feet in depth) where you'll get to give the dolphin a hand rub, tummy rub and kiss as well as swim in the open pool with the dolphins. Wear your swimsuit and bring a towel. Not recommended for pregnant women or those who suspect they are pregnant.

Virgin Gorda Highlights

Approximate Duration: 4 ½ hours

Level 2, Family Recommended

Take an approximately 40-minute cruise along the Sir Francis Drake Channel to Spanish Town, Virgin Gorda. Open safari buses take you on a 20-minute drive through Spanish Town to The Baths for swimming in the unique atmosphere of mammoth boulders, palms, and sea caves. Travel along the trails and boulders to discover hidden caves and sea pools.

This Signal Station is strategically placed on the highland of St. George. It commands a magnificent view from east through south to west. It was built in 1818 and was part of a chain of stations used to signal the approach of enemy ships. The Statue of the Lion was carved out of a single piece of rock in 1868 by an officer at the signal station and contains an interesting collection of military memorabilia.

They are some of the most beautiful places one can visit and support unique and rare plant life unseen elsewhere on the island. Our experienced local tour guides will take you through Harris or Jack-in-the-Box Gully, where towering trees, hanging vines, rare palms and unusual rock formations will be the highlights on an eco experience through Barbados' best kept secrets. After a thrilling yet relaxing hike, you'll be able to gain a deeper experience of the island as you make a descent into Coles Cave. You'll be issued helmets and head lamps and given a safety briefing and a short history of the area and the cave. After this, the adventure begins with a rope-assisted descent into the cavern which houses the entrance of the cave. This underground expedition takes you into the depths of the island. Once inside, you can marvel at the naturally formed sculptures within the walls of this underground wonder. Trek through streams of refreshing spring water as you listen to the therapeutic sounds of the waterfalls filling the naturally formed pools that are formed at intervals along the corridor of the system. After this unforgettable experience, return to the surface for a refreshing snack of locally made breads and a cool drink.

Approximate Duration: 3 ½ hours

Level 2

Travel off-road into the heart of the island in specially modified British-made Land Rovers, and discover the real beauty of exotic St. Kitts. Drive through quaint country villages, before traveling up into cool mountain forests, to later re-emerge on the islands opposite coast to return along the windswept Atlantic coastline. Stop at a number of sugar plantations and revel in the history of sugar cane cultivation on St. Kitts as you travel off the beaten track. Your experienced naturalist guide will give fascinating insights into the sugar plantation heritage of St. Kitts as well as the evolution of the sugar industry. The route takes you into parts of the lush rainforest, where you may catch a glimpse of shy green Vervet monkeys, and other tropical flora and fauna. Be sure to bring your camera for exquisite nature photos. Enjoy a light refreshment of exotic Caribbean fruit in season, home-made island juice drinks and local rum. Mmmm!

From there, drive across this winding mountain highway, before stopping at another photo locale with excellent views of the rugged coastline and Basseterre, the capital in the distance. Proceeding onwards, you arrive at a scenic lookout to hear stories of the Overseer's House and be entertained by tales of this environmentally protected area, which was once a thriving village. Upon returning from your leisurely wander, you climb into the truck and continue to the extreme tip of St. Kitts to Cockleshell Bay where you can take a plunge in the warm Caribbean Sea, explore for seashells and enjoy the views of Nevis our sister Island, across The Narrows, the channel separating the Federation. Then enjoy local island snacks, fruits in season and fruit juices, which are served to excite your taste buds. After this exhilarating excursion, you return to your ship via the same route.

Meander along a flat, looped trail deep into the cool green chambers of our rare, bio-diversity rich rainforest. Enjoy fresh home-made Caribbean juices, fruits in season, pastries and spring water, which are offered before and after the hike. Sample fresh, tropical fruit juices, as you listen to ole tales of years gone by.

Caribbean Scenic Rail

This unique 'island tour' runs in a complete circle around St. Kitts allowing visitors the opportunity to see the entire country by rail and highway in only three hours. No trip to this two-island federation is complete without the experience of traveling on the St. Kitts Scenic Railway, one of the most beautiful train rides in the world. This one-of-a-kind narrow gauge railroad was built almost a century ago to deliver sugar cane from the fields to the sugar mill in the capital city of Basseterre. The railway now provides a fascinating way to see the island from the comfort of double-decked railcars built specifically for touring the island of St. Kitts. All guests have a seat on both levels of the railcar. The upper level features a spacious open-air observation deck with panoramic views of the surrounding countryside. The lower level provides air-conditioned comfort with expansive six-foot vaulted windows. Island ambiance is evoked with comfortable rattan furniture, complimentary specialty drinks, island music sung by the Scenic Railway Choir, and a colorful narrative history of the Caribbean. On this memorable journey, the railway hugs the northeastern coastline where rippling fields of sugarcane stretch from the shoreline up to the mountains. The high volcanic peaks rise nearly 4,000 feet above sea level, coated with lush green rainforests. The train rolls across tall steel bridges spanning deep 'ghuts', or canyons, and winds through small villages and farms. Your railway tour narrator will point out abandoned sugar estates with overgrown chimneys and windmills, and provide insight into the island's unique history. Your experience is complimented by a scenic drive on board the Scenic Railway's sightseeing buses along the southwestern coast. Enjoy excellent vistas of Brimstone Hill Fortress, the British 'Gibraltar of the West Indies'; Middle Island where Thomas Jefferson's great-grandfather is buried, and the neighboring island of Nevis, birthplace of American statesman Alexander Hamilton, the first Secretary of the U.S. Treasury.

French in the battles of the 1600s provides a unique backdrop to many landmarks of local and international significance namely the Old Treasury Building, the Berkeley Memorial, the Public Market, the War Memorial and the Anglican Church. The tour takes you through the Frigate Bay area a haven for sun seekers, golfers and developers alike. Fortress National Park & Gardens

Your excursion gets off to a start with a driving tour of the French built, capital city of Basseterre founded in 1625. Within the confines of the city lie many landmarks of its undaunted past. The concentration of the two story buildings are dominated by Georgian architecture, cut stone work, cobblestone streets, squares, forts and monuments, all gentle reminders of the many cultures that once coincided on these beautiful shores. Your first stop is at Romney Manor, home of the world-famous Caribelle Batik. Visit the demonstration room, where the acclaimed artists illustrate the wax and dye process of Batik making. The Romney Manor Estate encompasses eight acres of historical ruins, ancient Carib Indian Rock drawings and a beautiful botanical garden. The tour then continues along the coastal road through remnants of sugar cane plantations to Brimstone Hill Fortress. At Brimstone Hill a video presentation on the fortress is shown for approximately seven minutes. This magnificent fortress, sitting impressively atop 38 acres of limestone and sulphur composites, is the result of 100 years of slave labor and has endured many wars fought between English, French and Spanish troops, for its control. From the fortress the tour returns to your ship via Basseterre’s Caribbean Sea coastal road.

From Basseterre, you’ll travel across the coastal roadway of the island dominated by a lush rolling landscape and distinct remnants of old chimneys and steeples – perhaps reminders of the islands humble beginnings. Your first stop is Romney Manor, home of Caribelle Batik affording shopping opportunities and a quite escape for those who want to relax in the comfort of their botanical gardens. Next en route is the Frigate Bay basin which provides a panorama of views inclusive of the St. Kitts Marriott and Royal Beach Casino, the Royal St. Kitts Golf Course and many of the island’s boutique hotels and inns emphasizing Caribbean elegance, style and charm. The Marriott provides an opportunity for shopping and refreshments.
