New Hire Policy

MMHS will begin hiring only candidates who commit to a nicotine free lifestyle effective on December 3, 2012. MMHS is among several other health systems in Michigan and Ohio who have adopted similar nicotine-free hiring policies. "It's the right thing to do for the health and well-being of the community."

Those who are candidates on or after December 3, 2012 will be requested at the pre-employment interview to sign a statement declaring they are nicotine free and can abide by a nicotine free work environment. All candidates will be tested for the presence of nicotine in their systems as part of the new hire physical exam. If the presence of nicotine is detected in the candidate's system, the candidate may reapply in 90 days for available positions.


