Program Information

- Maximum rebate allowable is \$500 per year per residential/farm account for all agricultural incentives.
- Rebates available for agricultural uses include heat lamps, lighting, heat pads, low-energy livestock waterers, high-efficiency water heaters, variable frequency drives, 3-phase premium efficiency motors, heat recovery, plate cooler/ pre-cooler, exhaust and circulating fans, and more.
- Contact an energy advisor at Butler County REC for additional information before purchasing and installing any new equipment.

Why Agricultural Incentives?

According to the American Council for an Energy-Efficient Economy, increasing efficiency in the agricultural sector can "improve the financial situation of small farms, have a significant effect on easing the burden on the grid, and decrease pollution and dependence on foreign oil."

The National Sustainable Agriculture Information service states: "With today's slim profit margins and the uncertainty of fuel supplies and prices, it makes sense to make every energy dollar go as far as possible. While U.S. farms have almost doubled their average energy efficiency over the past 25 years, high energy costs are putting many producers gravely at risk.

"Some farms and ranches are able to capture big energy savings by simply maintaining their equipment better or installing new high-efficiency motors, fans, or lighting."
