#### CONSIDER APPLYING FOR THIS SPECIAL AWARD TRIP!

Enclosed is a copy of the **National 4-H Conference Application Form**. This conference, which focuses on leadership, public awareness and 4-H program development, takes place each spring near Washington, DC. The conference is held at the National 4-H Youth Conference Center located in Chevy Chase, Maryland.

Six delegates are selected to attend from New Jersey each year. 4-H members interested in attending must work well in groups, have good communication skills and be leaders. They should also be interested in making a change in their community and be willing to work on a project upon their return.

I believe you should consider applying for this award trip. The application process is relatively simple and is as follows:

- 1. Applicants must be enrolled in **Grades 10-12** as of September 2014 and between **ages 15 and 19 years** old (as of January 1, 2015).
- 2. Your application is due to the county 4-H office by Wednesday, October 1, 2014.
- Interviews for National 4-H Conference candidates will be held on Saturday, November 1, 10:00 AM-1:30 PM in Martin Hall at the School of Environmental & Biological Sciences, G.H. Cook Campus, Rutgers University. (*There is no makeup date!*)

#### NATIONAL 4-H CONFERENCE SET FOR APRIL 2015

The 2015 National 4-H Conference will be held April 11-16 at the National 4-H Youth Conference Center in Chevy Chase, Maryland. Known as the "Secretary's Conference," National 4-H Conference is the premier youth development opportunity to engage youth assisting in the development of recommendations to help guide 4-H Youth Development Programs nationally and in their communities. The purpose of this working conference is to solicit input from a diverse crosssection of the Cooperative Extension System to strengthen and expand the 4-H Youth Development Program at local, state and national levels. The conference is administered by 4-H National Headquarters of the National Institute of Food and Agriculture (NIFA) within the United States Department of Agriculture.

Approximately 300 youth, volunteer leaders, and state and county Extension staff members from across the United States, the U.S. Territories, and the Canadian Provinces are expected to attend. New Jersey will be sending a delegation of six teen 4-H members and two adult chaperones. Teens must be in the 10-12 grades as of September 2014 in order to participate in the 2015 event. 4-H members interested in attending must work well in groups, have good communication skills and be leaders. They should also be interested in making a change in their community and be willing to work on a project upon their return.

Interested 4-H members must complete an application form available from the county 4-H office or on-line at <u>http://nj4h.rutgers.edu/leadership/nat4hconference/</u> *All applications are due to the county 4-H office by October 1, 2014*. Group and individual interviews will be held on Saturday, November 1 at the School of Environmental & Biological Sciences, Cook-Douglas Campus, Rutgers University.
