Precede the person's name with, Teacher (and/or) Mentor, Name

Return twice after the heading, and begin your abstract.

Return twice after each paragraph.

Instructions: Abstracts prepared by regional finalists will be published and distributed to all participating schools. To ensure uniformity and a quality publication, abstracts must be submitted on this form. The template is a guide for margins. Please type or print the abstract within the template.
