FANCHER SCHOLARSHIP GENERAL INFORMATION

FOR ALL APPLICANTS

- 1. Fred B. Fancher scholarships are granted annually to qualified Merced Union High School District students who have demonstrated an interest in the broad field of agriculture and who wish to pursue a course of study, directly or indirectly related to that field. An Agriculture major is defined as a program of related courses, successful completion of which, along with other requirements, is recognized by award of the appropriate degree. A major includes courses required by the department level prerequisites to the courses so required. Veterinary Medicine, Agricultural Economics, Agricultural Chemistry, etc. are acceptable majors. (See attached list.)
- 2. The student shall maintain a 2.5 GPA in one of the Merced Union High School District's agriculture programs or a 2.5 GPA in college and submit proof of such at time of application.
- 3. The student must enroll in an accredited California college and complete twelve (12) semester units each semester or 12 quarter units per quarter, based on a three quarter system.
- 4. Awards are currently made in the amount of \$1,500* for those students enrolling in a 4-year accredited California university or college and \$750* if enrolling in an accredited California community college. *The amount awarded shall depend upon the availability of funds as determined by the Fancher Scholarship Committee.
- 5. Application forms are available on January 7th, from the graduate's high school. They are also available on the district web site at http://goo.gl/Ll30h2 Application forms must be received at the address below on or before April 1.

The completed application packet shall consist of the following:

- A. Completed Fancher Scholarship Application Form.
- B. A written statement by the applicant listing plans and ambitions and what led to their interest in agriculture (250-300 words).
- C. An <u>official</u> high school transcript (7 semesters) or if a college applicant, <u>official</u> college transcript(s) of all colleges attended by the application deadline. <u>Applicants are responsible for</u> seeing that transcripts are received by the deadline date.
- D. <u>For high school seniors and initial college applicants ONLY</u> 1) Activity Record and References form, 2) Recommendation Statement.
- 6. Applicants may reapply each year and receive the scholarship for up to a maximum of 4 years.
- 7. On or about May 15th you will be notified of the amount of your award, or the reason for your denial.
