ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2012 - 2013

The 32nd General Body Meeting was conducted on 26-01-2013 at the Chakola Devassy Memorial Hall at 7.00 p.m. The Minutes of the last meeting was read over in the meeting and it was approved by the General Body Meeting unanimously. Annual Report was presented by the Secretary. After discussion, the same was approved unanimously. The Audited Statement of Accounts for the year ended 31-03-2012 was presented by the Treasurer and the same was also approved. M/s Balaram & Nandakumar were appointed as Auditors for the year 2012-13. The following amendments to the Bye-law of the Trust were presented by the Secretary. The same was approved unanimously.

General Body

Membership of the Academy shall be of 6 categories. a) Founder Members of the Trichur Tennis Trust. b) Life Membership of the Academy c) Ordinary Membership of the Academy d) Corporate Body Membership e) Honorary Membership f) Temporary Membership

4 a) The Management of the Academy shall be vested in the Managing Committee which is a policy making body of the Organisation. The Managing Committee shall consist of 12 members, major donors and major Patrons and Advisory Members without voting right in the Managing Committee. The 12 members shall be elected by Life Members, Ordinary Members, Founder Members of the Thrissur Tennis Trust and representatives of the Corporate bodies. Those eligible to stand for election for the Managing Committee are those belonging to the category of Life members, Ordinary members and the representatives of the corporate bodies who have completed 3 years after joining the Academy. Any member desirous for standing the election for the Managing Committee shall file the nomination form sponsored by 20 members of the Academy belonging to the category of Life Members or Ordinary members, Founder

General Body

Membership of the Academy shall be of 9 categories. (a) Founder Members of the Trichur Tennis Trust.(b) Major donors.(c) Advisory Members.(d) Life Members of the Academy.(e) Platinum Life Members.(f) Ordinary Members of the Academy.(g) Corporate Body Members.(h) Honorary Members.(i) Temporary Members.

4 a) Management of the Academy shall be vested in the Managing Committee which is a policy making body of the Organisation. The Managing Committee shall consist of 12 elected members, major donors and major Patrons and Advisory Members without voting right in the Managing Committee. The 12 members shall be elected by Life Members, Ordinary Members, Founder Members of the Thrissur Tennis Trust, major donors, major Patrons and Advisory Committee members representatives of the Corporate bodies. Those eligible to stand for election for the Managing Committee are those belonging to the category of Life members, Ordinary members and the representatives of the corporate bodies who have completed 3 years after joining the Academy. Any member desirous for standing the election for the Managing Committee shall file the nomination form sponsored by 20 members of the Academy belonging to the

members of the Thrissur Tennis Trust or representatives of the corporate bodies. The application shall be accompanied by a Letter of Willingness to serve in the Managing Committee, if elected, and should reach the Secretary 7 days prior to the Annual General Body Meeting. The application should be endorsed by the signature of each of the sponsoring members. A member of the Academy is entitled to sponsor only one candidate every year for election to the Managing Committee. Their term of the office shall be 3 years except for those re-elected. Each year 4 members of the Managing Committee in order of seniority of membership shall retire and new member shall be elected in their place. If there is a tie as to who should retire it shall be decided by lot. The retiring member shall have the right to stand for reelection, but can be a Committee member only for two consegutive terms. He then can contest for election only after a break of two years.

b) Life Membership of the Academy

This category includes all those members of the Trichur Tennis Trust who have converted their membership to that of Kinattingal Academy and Sports Complex and those who have paid Rs. 8,000/-, Rs. 20,000/-, Rs. 40,000/-, Rs. 60,000/- or join in future at the prevailing stipulated rate come under this category. From 31-01-2009 there shall be no difference between the privileges extended to both Founder Life Members and Associate Life Members. There shall be one single category called Life Members of the Academy. From 01-04--2012 onwards Membership donation to become a Life Member shall be Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs only).

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2 (b) (b). Platinum Members

Life Members of the Club including those who have received the membership as a nominee of original Life Members, upon payment of an additional donation of Rs. 30,000/-- (Rupees Thirty Thousand only) towards the Club will earn them the option of making their existing Life Membership into that of a Platinum Membership. This option will be available only upto 1-12-2013. A Platinum Membership will be governed by all the Rules of that of a Life Member, but will allow the holder to have certain exclusive privileges over that of a Life Member.(i) A Platinum Member can transfer his membership whenever he desires to the

c) Ordinary membership

Existing ordinary members can continue their membership. These members shall be required to pay a monthly subscription as fixed by the Managing Committee and revised periodically, if necessary. No new member will be admitted under this category from today (28-01-2012). The existing members can convert their membership under this category to Life Membership by paying the balance of the fee for a Life Membership on their date of joining 31-03-2012.

Managing Committee. The Managing Committee will reimburse the entire money that the said Platinum Member has paid towards his Membership. The money will be reimbursed only as long as a new member is inducted into the Academy and the time from surrendering the Membership to reimbursement cannot be hastened. The order of reimbursement will be according to the original list of applicants according to the date of conversion from a Life Member to that as a Platinum Member.(ii) A Platinum Member will be exempted from paying the Annual Maintenance Charges and the Luxury Tax whatever it may be as long as he holds the Membership.(iii) Once a Platinum Membership is transferred to the Academy, the member gives up all his rights as a member and his membership cannot be reinstalled. He can, however, re-apply for a new Membership as a fresh applicant with the prevailing rates at the time of the application.

b) Life Membership of the Academy

This category includes all those members of the Trichur Tennis Trust who have converted their membership to that of Kinattingal Academy and Sports Complex and those who have paid Rs. 8,000/-, Rs. 20,000/-, Rs. 40,000/-, Rs. 60,000/- or join in future at the prevailing stipulated rate come under this category. From 31-01-2009 there shall be no difference between the privileges extended to both Founder Life Members and Associate Life Members. There shall be one single category called Life Members of the Academy. From 27-01-2013 onwards Membership donation to become a Life Member shall be Rs.1,5

Existing in the Constitution and Rules-under 2(b)

In the event of the death of a Life member, his or her nominee or if the nominee's name is not on record, his or her legal heir as approved by the Managing Committee shall be accepted as a life member in the place of the deceased member. An application shall be made to the Secretary of the Academy accompanied by an application fee of Rs.25/- for this purpose.

c) Ordinary membership Existing ordinary members can continue their membership. These members shall be required to pay a monthly subscription as fixed by the Managing Committee and revised periodically, if necessary. No new member will be admitted under this category from today (28-01-2012). The existing members can convert their membership under this category to Life Membership by paying the balance of the fee for a Life Membership till as on their date of joining 30-06-2013.

Existing in the Constitution and Rules-under 2(b)

Proposed Approved with modifications

In the event of the death of a Life member, his or her nominee or if the nominee's name is not on record, his or her legal heir as approved by the Managing Committee shall be accepted as a life member in the place of the deceased member. An application shall be made to the Secretary of the Academy accompanied by an application fee of Rs.25/- for this purpose.

In the event of a life member who desires to transfer his membership to his/her wife or any son or daughter or father or mother or in the event of the death of a Life member his or her nominee or if the nominee's name is not on record, his or her legal heir as approved by the managing "committee and may be accepted a life member in the place of that member. An application shall be made to the Secretary of the Academy accompanied by an application fee of Rs.25/-for the purpose.

Adv. Joshy Pachan and Sri. Shaju M.A. presented separate Resolutions to extend the date of the next Annual General Body. The Managing Committee formulated an amendment in pursuance of the said resolution. The following were the amendment.

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Proposed Amendment-

11 GENERAL BODY

a) The first Annual General Body Meeting shall be held within 15 months from the date of registration of the Academy and thereafter within 12 months from the preceding Annual General Body Meeting.

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a) The first Annual General Body Meeting shall be held within 15 months from the date of registration of the Academy and thereafter within 14 months from the preceding Annual General Body Meeting but not including 31st March of the corresponding year.

Mr. Pankajakshan pointed out that the Annual General Body Meeting for the next year shall not exceed 31st March, 2014 which is the end of the financial year. It is also approved.

Sri. R. Venkitram moved an amendment to the Constitution with regard to corporate membership. The following was the amendment.

Existing

2 d) Corporate bodies or registered societies approved and accepted by the managing committee can become members of the academy. The number of members of the and the total amount required for membership for the corporate body shall be fixed by the managing committee. The cooperate body or registered society shall have only one collective vote in the academy meetings, for this purpose the cooperate body or registered society shall nominate their representative and inform the secretary in writing, the name of the representative.

Amend as

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The managing committee reserves the right to expel any member of the cooperate body or registered society, if he or she is found to be of undesirable character and conduct and does not abide by the rules and regulations of the academy. However the cooperate body or registered society shall have the right to nominate another of their members in place of the expelled member subject to the approval of the managing committee of the academy. The cooperate bodies or registered society shall have the right to change their nominees as and when necessary. The members of the cooperate bodies or registered societies can enjoy all the facilities of the academy. They are subject to all the rules and regulations governing the academy. Their membership will automatically cease if they cease to be members of their sponsoring body.

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From 30-01-2009 the minimum amount for membership for a corporate body or registered society shall be Rs. 4 lakhs for five members at the rate of Rs. 80,000 as fixed by the managing committee.

From 27-01-2013 the minimum amount for membership for a corporate body or registered society shall be Rs.6 lakhs for five members at the rate of Rs.1,20,000 as fixed by the managing committee.

Towards the 4 vacancies arising in the Managing Committee in place of Adv. Robson Paul, T.R.Sethu Nath, M.V.Babu, V.C NandaKumar 5 persons submitted. nominations. After the election by secret ballot, the following persons were elected.

RENOVATION OF THE CHAKKOLA DEVASSY MEMORIAL HALL

The above hall has always been an asset to our club. The asbestos roofing gave way to seepage. The roofing without air conditioning made the hall unusable, especially during summer season. The Managing Committee took all the measures to replace the roofing with thicker, powder coated profile sheets which not only stopped the seepage and made the hall cooler as well.. The hall has been thoroughly refurbished and air conditioned by spending about Rs. 22 lakhs, with the support of General Air Conditioning Company. The Hall is now also used as an additional badminton court which has answered the long lasting demands from the shuttle players.

THE PERMIT ROOM - TOP SPIN

Our long cherished dream of having a permit room in our club has come true. The permit room has been named approximately "TOPSPIN". We have already inaugurated the Permit Room on the New Year Eve. This will help us for hosting more events, meetings as well as affiliations with other Clubs.

CONSTRUCTION OF TWO NEW SYNTHETIC COURTS

The increase in the number of tennis players has been beyond our expectations. This has been partially due to the availability of a regular tennis coach in the club. The only one indoor court and one clay court outside, being insufficient to meet with the demands of the players. This forced the Managing Committee to think in terms of making two more synthetic courts in Australian Open Rebound Ace Surface. The reason being, the two outdoor courts we have in front of the club remained out of use during the rainy season. The estimated cost of the construction is around Rs. 33 lakhs. The work is completed. The entire renovation of the courts include the following works. Filling of the courts, to elevate the level about two feet on the eastern side, about 14 inches on the western side, Macadam tarring, raising the edge wall with 2x2 PVC

coated chain links, acrylic emulsion Surface, top coat with vibrant and durable finish resistant to UV rays and weather conditions. Water drainage will be provided for faster drying of the courts. Now the entire work is over and it will be inaugurated.

COMPOUND WALL AND GATE

Due to the widening of Punkunnam - Guruvayoor road, we were forced to demolish the existing compound wall and the gate. We take this as an blessing in disguise as it was much needed for us to give a new look to our entrance. With the help of a reputed Architect we have designed a new pattern to our gate and compound wall. The design has been planned in such a way that the very look of the gate and entry will announce the promotion of Tennis in our club. The work is completed.

CAMPS AND COACHING

Regular coaching camps for tennis, swimming, shuttle were conducted.

CHRISTMAS & NEW YEAR CELEBRATIONS

Christmas & New Year Celebrations were conducted on 31st December 2013. The Cultural Event NEW YEAR BASH 2014 was partially sponsored by M/s Kalyan Silks and co-sponsored by Nandilath G Mart. The Event was conducted in a grant manner. There were huge participations by the members and their families for the event.

Our Capital Fund amount into Rs. 23,48,500/- (Rupees Twenty Three lakhs Forty Eight Thousand and Five Hundred Only) is invested as Fixed Deposits in scheduled commercial banks

FACILITIES AVAILABLE

Facilities are listed below mainly for the benefits of the members who are stationed out of Thrissur and not frequently visiting the Club.

A) INDOOR STADIUM

The following facilities are available

- 1. TENNIS COURT All weather synthetic court with flood lights. At times this area is also being used for conducting functions.
- 2. INDOOR BADMINTION COURTS Wooden Court with flood lights erected on the stage of the stadium and the other in the Chakkola Devassy Memorial Hall. There is a demand from the Players to change the floormat in the Chakkola Devassy Memorial Hall for playing Shuttle Badminton.
- 3. HEALTH CLUB Modern, well equipped, well furnished workout center. This area is now air-conditioned, installed with TV and music system. This is the biggest workout centre in a club in Thrissur.
- 4. BILLIARDS ROOM In the first floor, there is a well designed Billiards room.
- 5. INDOOR TABLE TENNIS COURT Standard Table provided in the ground floor.
- 6. CARROMS Provided in the first floor mainly for the children

B) CLUB HOUSE BUILDING

- 1. INDOOR SWIMMING POOL We are providing coaching facility for swimming for children and for men.
- 2. CLUB HOUSE Now functioning in the ground floor of the building.
- 3. OPEN SIT-OUT AREA (VARANDHA) This is the main attraction of our Club house. Facing the Tennis Courts, the members can enjoy the game and relax.
- 4. LOUNGE WITH LCD TV A/c Board room
- RESTAURANT Now the restaurant is used in the old card room which is now air conditioned.

- 6. GUEST HOUSE Six rooms of various sizes with A/c and a common hall with reasonable rent. Members can utilize it for their guests also.
- 7. TOP SPIN THE PERMIT ROOM Well furnished Permit room for the members with 48 seating capacity. It is fully air-conditioned with music system and TVs. This is a sports bar. We can proudly say that this is the best permit room in a social club in Kerala.
- 8. AUDITORIUM Chakkola Devassy Memorial Hall which is recently air-conditioned and refurnished. It can accommodate about 800 persons for meeting or parties.
- 9. CARD ROOM A new card room has been constructed and is now functioning.

10. OUTDOOR FACILITIES

- 1. Tennis Court We have 3 outdoor Tennis Courts with flood lights
- 2. Party Area For conducting parties at the side of the Swimming Pool and the Varandha.
- 3. Open Ground/Parking area Outdoor cricket/football being played here. It can accommodate 150 Cars.
- 4. Volleyball Court
- 5. Basketball Court

Accounting Policies as at 31st March, 2013

Significant accounting policies adopted in the preparation of the accounts are as under:-

1. Basis of Accounting

The accounts and the financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost conventions in accordance with the generally accepted accounting principles in India, the Accounting Standards issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India and the Accounting Standards notified by the Central Government as per the provisions of Sec. 145 (2) of the Income Tax Act, 1961, except where otherwise stated. The accounting system followed is mercantile system of accounting with historical cost convention.

- 2. There are no contingent liabilities as at 31-3-2013
- 3. There is no change in the method of accounting followed from the previous year.
- 4. Prior period items, if any, are disclosed separately in the financial statements.

5. Depreciation

Depreciation is provided at the rates prescribed in the Income Tax Act under written down value method.

6. Revenue Recognition

Voluntary contributions and temporary membership registration fees is considered as income and credited to the Income and expenditure account. Interest is recognised on accrual basis. All other income are accounted on cash basis.

7. Expenditure

All expenditure are accounted on accrual basis

8. Fixed Assets

Fixed assets are accounted on historical cost basis less depreciation.

9 Goverment Grant

The grant recieved from the Central Government towards the cost of indoor stadium is credited to the indoor stadium asset account and depreciation on indoor stadium is provided on the net value after deducting the Government grant.

10. Investments

Investments are in the nature of bank fixed deposit which are considered as long term deposits and are valued at cost.

11. Staff Benefits

- 1) Gratuity: Gratuity is not provided for in the accounts since it is not allowable under the Income Tax Act, 1961. Gratuity will be accounted on cash basis.
- 2) Leave : The management decided to account un utilized leave salary on cash basis.
