

Navidad Valley Cattle Women 2013 Scholarship Rules

- Applicant must be a resident of Lavaca, Fayette, or Colorado counties.
- Applicant must be a senior in high school or the equivalent thereof.
- Applicant must submit a completed NVCW application along with an essay (one page—single or double spaced) about her/himself, any agricultural influences and goals, involvement in the beef industry, and goals in life.
- Applicant must submit a copy of his/her transcript through mid-term of their senior year, rank, SAT or ACT score, and GPA.
- The winning applicant(s) will be paid a one-time award of \$500 or more to be used toward tuition or other education-related expenses. The scholarship must be accepted in the year that it is won. If this does not occur, the scholarship money will be returned to the Navidad Valley Cattle Women Scholarship Fund.
- The winner may be asked to attend the April Navidad Valley Cattle Women's monthly membership meeting.
- Payment of scholarship will be made when Navidad Valley Cattle Women has received proof of enrollment at an accredited college, university, or technical school. Scholarship recipients will be chosen by Navidad Valley Cattle Women Scholarship Committee Members.
