Great Plains Hunting Retriever Club invites you to our back-to-back Regular Licensed Hunts on Saturday May 4 and Sunday May 5, 2013 at the Lilley Sand and Gravel, 11970 W. Platte River Dr, Wood River, Nebraska. Take I-80 Exit 300 south on Prosser Rd to the intersection of W. Platte River Dr.

Entries: Entries are limited to the number shown on the premium. The pre-registration deadline is April 26, 2013. Dogs may be entered the day of the test if openings are available, however, late entries will not be printed in the Hunt Test Catalog. Running order is based on random drawing of entries received.

Running order may be altered to accommodate extenuating circumstances.

Scratch Policy: There will be no refunds for "scratches" without a veterinarian's certificate.

Check-in: Check-in will begin at 7:00 AM at the Hunt Test Headquarters.

Handlers meeting will be at 7:20 AM, and the Hunt Test will begin at 8:00 AM.

Clothing and Gear: All participants must wear hunting attire appropriate for a Nebraska duck, dark goose, or dove hunt. Waders may be required in all categories. Rain gear, sun-screen, and bug repellent are suggested. Bring plenty of water for yourself and your dog.

Club Social: A social on Saturday night at Meier's Ballroom in downtown Gibbon, Nebraska (809 Front Street). A meal for the reasonable cost of \$10.00 will be available. The food will be great and this is a good time to chat with old friends and make new ones. Ribbons will be awarded to handlers and dogs that passed on Saturday. A raffle will be held with lots of very nice items.

Lunch: Lunch will not be served on the grounds but restaurants are available in nearby Wood River, Shelton and Alda.

Grounds: The test will be held on private property. Please respect the grounds. Drive only on designated roads and do not litter.

The person(s) signing this entry form acknowledges that the use, handling, and firing of firearms involves a risk of physical injury to any individual undertaking such activities and I/we expressly assume such risk and waive any claim I/we may state against GPHRC, HRC, UKC, or any of their officers, owners, agents, servants, employees, directors, or volunteers as a result of physical injury incurred in said activities.

The person(s) signing this entry form acknowledges that the use, handling, hunting, and training of dogs involves a risk of physical injury to any individual undertaking such activities including the risk of dog bite; and that a dog, irrespective of its training and usual past behavior and characteristics, may act or react unpredictably at times based upon instinct or fright which, likewise is an inherent risk assumed by the person interacting with the dog.
