ITEM #1 - DIRECTORY

Please send in your dues (check or money order only please) with the Membership Form. This does not include your membership to the Colts Neck High School PTSO.

ITEM #3 – COMMITTEES

A very important part of our club is the formation and operation of "committees". Currently, we have eight established committees. They are as follows: (1) Hospitality (2) Events (3) Community Service (4) Military Ball (Ad Journal-subcommittee) (5) Public Relations (6) Photographer/Year Book (7) Drill Competition hosted by CNHS (8) Scholarship. Ad Journal Chair/Co-Chair: Coordinating ads as they are received and laying out in booklet given night of Military Ball. Members: Assist chair persons. We hope to have 100% participation from every Cadet in selling of Ads.

Drill Competition Chair/Co-Chair: Coordinate donation of food items and coordinating help for day of Drill Competition to be held at CNHS, March 2015. **Members**: Assist chair persons, and assist on day of competition.

Scholarship Chair/Co-Chair: Present scholarship opportunity to NJROTC Seniors, review applications and award four \$500 scholarships to deserving seniors. **Freshman Members**: review applications and vote on deserving seniors to receive awards.
