Waiver, Release and Consent Agreement

For and in consideration of free admission into Variety – The Children's Charity's "Variety at Play Mix-In Weekend at Sesame Place," an event held on October 13-14, 2012, I, the undersigned, on behalf of myself and as parent and/or legal guardian of all children accompanying my group, do hereby agree as follows:

VARIETY AT PLAY MIX-IN WEEKEND FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. Will the park be open to the general public?

A. Yes. Unlike Variety's other Sesame Place events in the past, this one will be open to everyone.

Q. Do I need to specify which day (Oct. 13th or 14th) I want to attend?

A. No. The tickets will be valid for either day you choose. Variety does not need to know which day you are attending.

Q. Can I use my tickets for both days (Oct. 13th & 14th)?

A. No. Your tickets will only scan once. If you decide to go on October 13th, your tickets will not be accepted on October 14th.

Q. Where is Sesame Place?

A. Sesame Place is located at 100 Sesame Road, Langhorne, PA 19047, in Bucks County about 20 minutes outside of Philadelphia. For directions, please go to http://www.sesameplace.com/sesame2/plan.aspx?id=directions-getting-there

Q. How do I register?

A. You may register on Variety's website at www.varietyphila.org/events or by filling out our registration form and mailing/faxing it to us.

Q. My child isn't registered with Variety; can we still attend the event?

A. Yes. As long as your child has a diagnosed physical or developmental disability, he/she can attend the event regardless of whether he/she has participated in any of Variety's other programs.

Q. Is there a cost to participate in this event?

A. For the child with a disability and his/her immediate family members, admission tickets are free. There is, however, a \$15 parking fee per car. This will be paid at the gate on the day of the event. Please do not send money ahead of time.

Q. I have more than one child with a disability, how do I register them?

A. Please fill out a form for each child with a disability. If you are registering online, please register one child along with the family members that will be attending, submit that form, then begin a new one with just the name of the second child with a disability and a parent/guardian. If you are using a paper form, please fill out a separate form for each child with a disability and staple them together.

Q. Do you require verification from a doctor of my child's disability?

A. Yes. In order for us to process your event registration form, you must submit Variety's "Application for Enrollment." This is a one-time form that will verify your child's disability. Your child's form will be kept on file for future events and programs. Please visit http://www.varietyphila.org/media/docs/Application for Enrollment 2012 as of 8-28-12.pdf to learn more and download the form. *IF YOU HAVE ALREADY SUBMITTED THIS FORM, PLEASE DO NOT RESUBMIT IT.*

Q. Who can come to Sesame Place with me on the day of the event?

A. We ask that only immediate family members attend the event. This includes parent/guardian, brothers & sisters. An aide (TSS) or a nurse may also attend if necessary. We cannot provide tickets for friends, neighbors, cousins, aunts/uncles, grandparents, bus drivers, etc.

Q. What if I have more than 6 people in my immediate family?

A. If you have a family of more than 6, we will provide additional tickets – but only for IMMEDIATE family members (parents, siblings). You will see that there is only room for six entries through our online form. If you need additional tickets for other siblings, please call our office. If you are using a paper form, please just list the additional people below the box or on a separate sheet of paper.

Q. What if other people want to come with us, but they are not immediate family members?

A. Tickets can be purchased for the full price at the park on the day of the event. General Admission for Sesame Place is \$59.99 per person.

Q. I have a baby, does he/she need a ticket?

A. Children <u>under</u> 2 years of age do not need a ticket.

Q. Where are my tickets?

A. We will be sending tickets in the mail. Please print out your registration confirmation and bring your tickets with you on the day of the event. If you do not receive your tickets by Wednesday, October 10th, please call our office at (215) 735-0803.

Q. Can I use these tickets on a different day?

A. No. Tickets distributed by Variety are valid ONLY on October 13th OR 14th.

Q. Where are hotels near Sesame?

Q. Can I bring food into the park?

A. Yes. Small coolers for baby food or medicine are permitted inside the park. The maximum size of an acceptable cooler is 7 quarts or no larger than 12" x 12" x 10". If you choose to bring a picnic lunch, two picnic areas are available outside the park, one in the Preferred Parking Lot and the other in the General Parking Lot. If leaving the park to enjoy your picnic lunch, please have your hand stamped for re-admittance. No glass bottles are allowed inside the park.

Q. Are there places to eat within the park?

A. Yes. There are several options for dining within the park. For more information about dining options, rides, attractions, etc., please visit www.sesameplace.com.

Q. Is there a rain date?

A. No. This event will be held rain or shine.

Q. Will the rides be open?

A. Yes, some of the rides will be open including Elmo's Cloud Chaser, Blast Off, Flyin' Fish, Peek a Bug, Grover's World Twirl, Sunny Day Carousel, Big Bird's Balloon Race and Grover's Vapor Trail (weather depending).

Q. Do you do this more than once a year?

A. Yes. Variety and Sesame Place also team up for a special weekend at Sesame Place in April and have also had a mix-in event in December. During the weekend we will have one day just for kids with autism, followed by our Sesame Place Challenge for children with all disabilities. Please check Variety's website for event dates, registration typically opens 6 weeks before the event.

Q. I don't have a car. How can I get to the park?

A. You can get to Sesame Place via SEPTA and NJ Transit. Please visit SEPTA or NJ Transit's website for more route information. We are sorry, but Variety cannot provide transportation to or from the park.
