	I've completed all fields on pages three and four of this packet.
	I've gotten permission from a parent or guardian to participate in TexPREP. Both my parent/guardian and I have signed the application.
	I've obtained a teacher recommendation from a math teacher (page five of this application) and a science teacher, English teacher, or school counselor (page six of this application).
	I've included an official copy of my current report card. (Report cards must include current information on student conduct and indicate any honor, pre-AP, or AP courses. If you have lost your report card, ask your school counselor for a duplicate on letter and signed by the counselor or school principal. If you are not currently taking a math or science course, you must also include an official transcript from your school.)
	I've included a 100-200 word essay answering the following question: Why do you want to attend TexPREP?
	On a separate piece of paper, I've listed any activities or special projects I have completed in mathematics or science. (For example, you can include awards, pre-AP or AP classes, science fairs, club or competitions, etc.)
	Make a copy of all documents for your records.
