Application and Permission Form Instructions

Return forms to PYT Producers. <u>Do not send to Foothill College</u>.

PYT is fortunate to be a member of the Foothill Arts Alliance, which subsidizes the cost of our productions. Participation fees and ticket sales cover only a portion of PYT's costs – without it we would have to charge more per child that participates. The amount of funding received depends entirely on how many cast members complete the required forms. Essentially, Foothill is paying PYT for the drama instruction your child receives, but to receive this funding each child must be enrolled in the PYT class at Foothill College. To get funding from the Alliance, each cast member must fill out **two** forms: 1) the application and 2) the permission. Each cast member gets college credit for participating in the show – there is no further obligation beyond submitting these forms. If you choose not to participate in this program, you will be charged a \$75 fee, which is equivalent to the funds we are provided by Foothill for each child that registers.

APPLICATION (front and back)

Most questions are self-explanatory. Below are answers to frequently asked questions.

- **Item 2**: During the school year (Fall-Winter-Spring Quarters) another application is not needed if you participate in consecutive shows. If you skip a show, a new application will be needed. Also, the summer show always requires a new application.
- Item 5: Proposed Major, leave blank
- Item 14: Leave blank if not in high school
- Common answers:
 - Item 16 (M) Undecided on goal Item 17 – (1) Special admit student currently enrolled in K-12 Item 18 – Enter graduation year, or leave blank
 - **Item 19** (Y) Special Admission Student. Currently enrolled in K-12.
- Cast members, <u>not parents</u>, should sign back of application.

K-12 PERMISSION

- Valid for the school year, check current and subsequent quarters. Summer show always requires new Permission form.
- Indicate "PYT Production" as the course at Foothill College.
- Principal or school administrator must sign. School secretaries are often authorized to sign.
- Some schools use their address stamp as the official school seal.
- Parents must also sign.
