Gingerbread House Night FAQs:

Why do we need to pay for the houses? Gingerbread House Night has grown to be a wonderfully huge event. To cover icing costs and be able to make it the best night possible we have had to charge a small fee.

What if we need an extra house? Please be sure to order a house for each person who is attending. Unfortunately, we cannot fill orders the night of the event as the event is based on RSVP numbers. Extra houses are not guaranteed to be available that evening. Thank you for your RSVP!!

How will I know my order has been received? A list of orders will be in the office.

This event is for Cooper Mountain Elementary School families to come together to make candy houses. Parents must pick up the house kits during the event and provide supervision at all times.

What should I bring? Please bring a sturdy plate or cardboard for your house to be carried home on. You can also bring a selection of your own candy to decorate if you do not choose to purchase an assorted candy bag for \$2. Successful decorating items might include candy, pretzels, crackers, marshmallow snowmen, etc.

How big are the candy bags for sales? They will be a sandwich bag size of assorted candies appropriate for creative decorating of your house. We suggest you order one bag per house. You are welcome to bring additional candy as well.
