LOCATION: Beloit Memorial Hospital, - 1969 W. Hart Road, Beloit, Wisconsin

ENTRY FEE: Individual: \$40 before May 17, \$50 Race Day.

Team: \$90 before May 17, \$110 Race Day.

Make check payable to the Stateline Family YMCA. Fee must accompany entry form. Fee includes a Tech shirt and refreshments. (No refunds) There is no guarantee on availability of shirt sizes for registrations received on or near race day.

REGISTER: Registration Deadline: 8:45 a.m. on Race Day.

Limit - 300 participants Awards - Trophies to overall male/female 1st place finishers (not eligible for age division awards). Awards to 1st-3rd place in each age division (male/female). Awards to 1st-3rd place finishers in the Clydesdale & Athena Divisions.

HOSPITALITY: Hospitality will be provided to all participants throughout event.

Packet Pickup: Includes race numbers, pins, and T-shirt. Friday, May 16th 11 a.m. -2 p.m. at the Stateline Family YMCA Race day packet pickup: 7:30-8:30 a.m. at Beloit Memorial Hospital.
