Concurrent Scholarship Guidelines



Northeast Texas Community College provides institutional scholarship awards for high school students who wish to be concurrently enrolled at the college.

The scholarship awards are need based and should be administered according to the guidelines listed below:

1. Students must be approved for admission to NTCC before applying for the scholarship.
2. Students receiving this scholarship must enroll in a minimum of three credit hours.
3. Scholarship awards are for tuition, fees, and book charges only, up to a maximum of \$200.00.
4. Students applying for this scholarship must provide a copy of their legal guardian's 2006 Federal income tax return or document untaxed income.
5. To qualify, you must use the family income levels listed below.

If family income as indicated on the 2006 Federal income tax form is greater than that identified for the family, the student will not be eligible for the scholarship.
