ACADEMIC SKILLS CENTER Peer Tutor / Supplemental Instruction Leader Application Packet

Please read this document carefully.

Working as a Peer Tutor or Supplemental Instruction Leader is an excellent job experience. The skills you will learn and practice are applicable to any future profession you choose to pursue. In addition, you will be working with a great group of people!

This packet includes both the application and two (2) faculty recommendation forms (including a cover letter to faculty member). Please print out all six pages and distribute the recommendation forms per the instructions below. The recommendation forms should be returned directly from the faculty member to the ASC. In order to complete the application process for either or both positions, the following documentation is required.

- 1. Completed application page
- 2. Two (2) completed recommendation forms
- **3.** Unofficial transcripts from any other university or college attended besides Oakland University

Please note that your application form **must include a personal statement.** You will find the directions outlined in the section labeled "paragraph" on the bottom of the actual application page. The statement can be written on the reverse side of the actual application page or attached separately if you prefer. This statement should describe the academic and personality traits that you think would make you a strong Peer Tutor or SI Leader.

Recommendation forms should be completed by faculty members at Oakland University in the discipline(s) in which you wish to tutor or SI. Two forms are required. If you are only asking to work in one subject area, then your second recommendation form can be completed by any faculty member you have taken a class from. The reverse side of the recommendation form explains to the faculty member the qualities that we seek in our Peer Tutors and SI Leaders. (You should be sure to complete the top portion of each form and indicate whether or not you wish to have access to the recommendation after it has been completed.)

A complete application file is necessary in order to be considered for a position in the ASC. If you do not receive a phone call or e-mail to set up an interview it is very likely due to a missing form in your file. Please call the Academic Skills Center at (248) 370-4215 if you have not heard from us and it has been **more than** two weeks since turning in your application.
