GUIDELINES:

- 1. Following the decentralization of approval of educational tours, an application to a given Reserve/Park (Protected Area) is handled by the district office responsible for that protected area according to the addresses provided at the end of the application form. For example, for visits to Chobe National Park and Moremi Game Reserve (the two areas are in different districts) hence two applications have to be completed one to Kasane and another one to Maun to be processed independently by the two wildlife offices. If the visits are in two or more areas that fall under the same district office (Moremi and Makgadikgadi) then only one application should be completed.
- 2. Applications can only be approved when accompanied by an itinerary and permissible number of students/touring group members as well as clear educational objective(s) of the trip.
- 3. The Department of Wildlife & National Parks (DWNP) will provide a guide and where possible camping equipment and teaching aids.
- 4. Park fees (entry and camping fees) has to be paid by all educational groups visiting the protected areas in Botswana as specified in the national Parks and Game Reserves Regulation of 2000 and the Educational Game Reserves Regulations of 2004.
- 5. Prevention against Malaria should be taken when visiting the Northern Parks
- 6. The Department of Wildlife & National Parks does not provide transport for educational trips
