- 5. Demonstrates collaborative efforts between Broken Arrow Public Schools and the community.

Applications will be reviewed by the Partners in Education Advisory Board. Grant recipients will be notified in January 2013 of their award.

All funds granted by the Partners in Education are to be used exclusively for the project or program listed in the grant application. The Partners in Education Advisory Board reserves the right to accept or reject any application and to approve or disapprove any proposal for funding. The Partners in Education Advisory Board also reserves the right to change the application criteria at any time. Other limitations may apply and will be evaluated on an individual basis.
