

Spring 2011 Trout Stocking

The Rockingham County Conservation District will be offering New Hampshire raised **RAINBOW AND BROOK TROUT** available in sizes of 6-8 & 10-12 inch for spring pond stocking. The 6-8 inch are available in oxygenated bags of 25 all ready for **pick-up on Saturday, April 23, 2011 between 1:00-1:30 PM at the District Office, 110 North Road, Brentwood, NH.** *Please be advised - If you fail to show up at the proper pick-up time you will forfeit your order (no refunds). Arriving a little early is much safer than too late. The district must pay for all trout ordered. Once they leave the hatchery, they can not be returned.* The large trout have to be delivered directly to your pond.

Please follow the instructions for pond delivery (if ordering small trout also, they will be delivered along with the large). **Direct delivery to your pond will be made when you order a minimum of (50) fifty 10 to 12 inch or (200) two hundred 6 to 8 inch.** Individual arrangements will be made for direct delivery to your pond site for minimum order. Deliveries will be Saturday afternoon, April 23rd as time permits. Since exact location of the pond must be given in order for delivery to occur, you must draw a map on the back of this order form even if we have been there before. Please include a daytime phone number so we may contact you for scheduling. *Your support helps us fund local soil and water conservation programs.*

Our NH based hatchery is licensed and inspected annually, again this year they have received a disease-free CLASS A Health Report.

The order form can be found below. Please return it along with your payment (sorry no credit cards) *no later than Wednesday, April 20th* to: RCCD, 110 North Road, Brentwood, NH 03833-6614. **Orders received without payment will not be processed. Pickup is scheduled for Saturday, April 23rd, 1:00-1:30 PM at 110 North Road, Brentwood (watch for sign) and please don't be late.** mark your calendar, *we can not be responsible for trout not picked up and there will be no refunds.* Contact RCCD via: phone (603) 679-2790 fax 679-2860 e-mail rced@rockinghamccd.org for our flyer. Important: The trout must be released into your pond as soon as possible.
Transporting within a 45 mile radius of Brentwood is recommended.

Please note: Due to the hatchery's busy spring stocking schedule, we will not be able to guarantee any alternative delivery dates, so if you want to stock or restock your pond, now is the time to do it.
