- **10** A Statutory Declaration under the Statutory Declarations Act 1959 (Cwlth) may be made before:
 - (1) A person who is currently licensed or registered under a law to practice in one of the following occupations: Chiropractor, Dentist, Legal Practitioner, Medical Practitioner, Nurse, Optometrist, Patent Attorney, Pharmacist, Physiotherapist, Psychologist, Trade Marks Attorney, Veterinary Surgeon.
 - A person who is enrolled on the roll of the Supreme Court of the State or Territory, Or the High Court of Australia, as a legal Practitioner (However described); or A Person on the following list:
 - Agent of the Australian Postal Corporation who is in charge of an office supplying postal services to the public
 - Australian Consular Officer or Australian Diplomatic Officer (within the meaning of the Consular Fees Act 1955)
 - Bailiff
 - Bank officer with 5 or more continuous years of service
 - Building society officer with 5 or more years of continuous service
 - Chief executive officer of a Commonwealth court
 - · Clerk of a court
 - · Commissioner for Affidavits
 - · Commissioner for Declarations
 - Credit union officer with 5 or more years of continuous service
