Manchester City FC 'CITC Giving' promotion

- 1. The promoter is Manchester City Football Club (MCFC), also known as 'the Club'.
- Applications for the CITC Giving promotion will be accepted from charities with a registered charity number from the Charity Commission, not-for-profit organisations, organisations receiving voluntary aid (eg. hospices and hospitals) and voluntary organisations.
- **3.** Please note, we are not inviting applications from schools, amateur sports clubs or Scout/Guide groups. Details of further initiatives for these sectors will be announced in the coming months.
- 4. Only one application per registered address of an organisation/charity will be accepted. All applicants must have the consent of the organisation/charity they are applying on behalf of to take part in the promotion.
- 5. Applications are only invited from organisations/charities within the Manchester city region, ie Manchester, Tameside, Bolton, Bury, Stockport, Rochdale, Warrington, Trafford, Salford, Oldham and Wigan.
- 6. All applications must be submitted by one of the following:

- 7. The closing date for applications is 5pm on 9th July 2010.
- 8. Applications put forward to the shortlisting stage will be chosen by the CITC Giving judging panel, comprising club staff.
- The decisions of the judging panel are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 10. The winning organisations/charities will be voted for by Manchester City fans and staff via the shortlist on the Club's official website, www.mcfc.co.uk. Every shortlisted organisation/charity will be notified of their inclusion on the shortlist before polling begins. Please note, Manchester City fans will need to input their Supporter Number to be able to register their vote, with only one vote being allowed per Supporter Number.
- Winning organisations will be contacted no later than 31st July 2010. The number of winning organisations/monetary contributions made will be at the sole discretion of Manchester City FC.
- 12. Winning applicants may have the right to use certain intellectual property rights of Manchester City FC and such rights will be restricted and subject to a strict approval process. All intellectual property will be retained by Manchester City FC.
- **13.** By entering this promotion, you agree to such publicity as required by Manchester City FC, including the use of images and logos.
- 14. Manchester City FC has the right to withdraw an application if it becomes clear that activity proposed on the application form was false or misleading.
- **15.** Manchester City FC has the right to withdraw an application if it becomes clear that evidence supporting the application is found to be false. Manchester City FC shall be permitted to exclude any application at any time at its sole discretion.
- 16. Manchester City FC shall have the irrevocable, assignable right to exercise all current and future rights in applications in any publication or service and in any current or future media worldwide.
- **17.** All organisations/charities applying for a monetary contribution must have a registered UK bank account. Payments cannot be made to personal accounts.
- **18.** The value of any monetary contribution awarded is entirely at the discretion of Manchester City FC.
- 19. Winning organisations must claim their award within the 2010/2011 season. For the purposes of this promotion, the season will begin on 1st August 2010 and end on 31st July 2011.
- 20. If your organisation is granted a monetary contribution, you must keep all receipts for money you spend, as they will be required for monitoring purposes.
- 21. If your project requires building works, no monetary contribution will be awarded without both the approval of Manchester City FC and proof of authorisation from the relevant local authority, as required.
