## Updates from the HR Liaison Meeting

-ePerformance (Admin evaluations) second-level approvals are due by 9/30/13

- 2014 Benefits Open Enrollment: 8am 10/21/12 through 6pm 11/8/13
  - No major changes to carriers/premiums
  - Confirm/update address in PeopleFirst by 10/4/13
  - Benefits packages should be received the week of 10/7/13
  - Enrollment process only through PeopleFirst: https://peoplefirst.myflorida.com or 866-663-4735
- PPACA (Patient Protection Affordable Care Act) Update

- Eligible temporary (OPS) employees who worked on average of 30hrs/week during measurement period will be receiving open enrollment packages the week of 10/7. They will be mailed to the address on file in PSHR. Health coverage would begin 1/1/14.

- In order to make sure the University is in compliance, all hours worked must be recorded in the PSHR system.

- CCRP (Compensation/Classification Redesign Project) Update

- Moratorium extended through 12/15/13 for the following actions: reclassifications, updates to positions, pay plan changes, added duties.
