Thursday October 25, 2012

12:00 Noon: Registration begins and hospitality room opens.

5:00 PM: Welcome Reception. This is the first planned activity. After a few welcome remarks and admin announcements everyone will be asked to introduce him/herself and spouse. The cash bar will open and light hors d'oeuvres will be served. Dinner is on your own! Friday October 26, 2012

Breakfast will be on your own. Eat at your leisure keeping in mind the tour loads up at 8:45 AM.

8:45 AM: Load up the bus and move out. Today is one of the big reasons you came to Norfolk. Today will take you through Norfolk where you will learn about the city's colorful 325 year history. You'll see the stately homes along the Hague, old St Paul's church, the Moses Myers House, the Chrysler Museum of Art, the Free Mason District, the restored waterfront and more. Next you'll visit Norfolk's premier waterfront attraction, Nauticus, The National Maritime Museum, including the Battleship, USS Wisconsin. Nauticus is a thriving campus of attractions that explores the economic naval, and natural wonders of the sea. Also, here is The Hampton Roads Naval Museum. You may also take a guided tour of the USS Wisconsin. This great ship participated in WW II, the Korean War, and most recently the Gulf War. From there you are off to Norfolk Naval Station, the largest Navy Base in the world. Home port to 78 ships and 26 air squadrons. Your tour will take you past the 14 piers, thru the Naval Air Station, Admiral's Row, plus (hopefully) a visit (not guaranteed) to an active duty ship. We are planning to visit an active duty ship, but that depends on the Base Commander - he can withdraw permission at any time. Lunch will be in one of the on base clubs. Please note that everyone entering the naval base must have a government issued ID (driver's license, military ID, passport). Bags larger than a purse are not allowed and will be confiscated. Please do not bring pocket knives, nail files, or scissors with you – they will be confiscated. Your naval guide will tell you where pictures can be taken. A list of names and state of residence must be provided to base security three weeks before the visit. THERE CAN BE NO LAST MINUTE SIGN-UP - YOU MUST REGISTER IN TIME ENOUGH TO MEET THE THREE WEEK DEADLINE. There is a minimum of 25 persons for the tour to go. Less than 25 the tour will be cancelled or the tour will be cancelled or the price will be adjusted to cover the difference. You will return to the Hilton around 4:00 PM. This tour is an optional tour so the cost is not included in the either of the options.
