The National WWII Museum's exhibits cover the epic and global scale of the war that changed the world, in a voice that is intimate and personal right in the heart of New Orleans. Exhibits not only highlight the role of world leaders, but also the everyday men and women who found the strength and courage to accomplish the extraordinary.

Currently housed in three buildings, each arranged around central themes of the war, Museum exhibits offer visitors an opportunity to experience the war through the eyes of the men and women who lived it. Interactives, oral histories and personal vignettes add a meaningful perspective. With one of the richest historical museums in New Orleans, exhibits from The National WWII Museum span the years leading up to and following the war. The Museum has a large collection of memoirs of wartime experiences, as well as an impressive collection of oral histories conducted with veterans from all branches and who served on all fronts. This museum is a "must see" for every veteran. Within the museum there are several exhibits and/or "hands on" activities that require additional admissions. If you choose to visit one of these, you must individually pay that admission, it is not covered in the basic admission fee. You can have lunch on your own at the cafeteria.

At approximately 12:30 PM you will leave the Museum to visit the Fleet Week ships that are anchored at the piers. The 2015 event will feature six vessels moored along the Mississippi River's east bank and opened for public tours. Five of the scheduled vessels are active warships from three countries. One of those is the USS Cole, the guided-missile destroyer that was attacked in Yemen in 2000 by suicide bombers who killed 17 U.S. sailors and injured 39 others. The flagship for the visit is to be the USS Wasp, the flattop amphibious assault ship. The Coast Guard Barque Eagle, is scheduled to be here. It will be the only tall ship this time. In addition to the Eagle, Cole and Wasp, ships tentatively scheduled for the 2015 event are the Arleigh Burke-class destroyer USS James E. Williams, the Canadian destroyer HMCS Athabaskan and Great Britain's HMS Lancaster, known as "The Queen's Frigate." France is considering sending a warship as well. There is a minimum of 30 persons for the tour to go at the quoted price. Less than thirty persons the tour will be cancelled or the price adjusted to cover the difference. Since this is an optional tour, the cost is not included in either of the options. You must register separately; see the Registration Form, Adjustment Opportunities Block and add Saturday's tour.

6:00 PM: Social Hour and photo session. Enjoy your favorite beverage and be sure to have your photo taken for inclusion in the 2015 reunion memory book.
