Mounted sessions will be divided by skill level throughout the day.

Unmounted sessions will be addressed during lunch, between mounted sessions, and at the end of the learning day.

Directions to Airborne Stables: Turn East onto 161st St. from Highway 75. (161st St. is one mile past the Kiefer/Bixby exit if you are coming from the north) Go through the intersections of Elwood and Peoria (approximately 2 miles) heading east. The gravel driveway is approximately a half mile east of Peoria on the north side of the road. There is white board fencing with a Jewel Quarter Horse sign on

the other side of the road. The driveway is nearly 1/2 a mile and Airborne Stables is at the very end.

Negative Coggins within the last 12 months must be shown at check in.
Please bring a water bucket and hay for your horse during the day.
Bring a sack lunch and drink. Dessert will be provided.
Protective Headgear required when mounted. Safety vest required for cross country jumping. **Mounted sessions will begin at 9:00 AM so please be ready beforehand.**
