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# **NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATION IN FEBRUARY/MARCH 2009**

## **1. INTRODUCTION**

The Gauteng Department of Education will conduct the National Senior Certificate Supplementary Examinations from **17 February 2009 to 25 March 2009**.

## **2. PURPOSE**

To inform heads of institutions and District Offices of the National Senior Certificate Supplementary Examination to be conducted in February and March 2009.

## **3. LEGISLATIVE FRAMEWORK**

- 3.1. National Education Policy Act, 1996 (Act. No.27 of 1996).
- 3.2. South African Schools Act, 1996 (Act No. 84 of 1996).
- 3.3. National Policy on the Conduct, Administration and Management of the Assessment of the Senior Certificate as published in Government Gazette, No. 26789, Volume No. 471 of 17 September 2004.
- 3.4. Regulations for the Conduct, Administration and Management of Assessment for the Senior Certificate as published in the Government Gazette No. 28156, Volume 484, of October 2005.
- 3.5. An addendum to the Policy document, the National Senior Certificate: A qualification at Level 4 on the National Qualifications Framework (NQF) regarding Learners with Special Needs as published in the Government Gazette No. 29466, Volume 1266 of 11 December 2006.
- 3.6. National Protocol on Assessment for Schools in the General Education and Training Band (Grades R – 12) 21 October 2005 and Amendment as published in the Government Gazette No. 29467, Volume 498 of 11 December 2006.
- 3.7. National Policy on the Conduct, Administration and Management of Assessment of the National Certificate: A Qualification at Level 4 on the National Qualifications Framework (NQF) as published in the Government Gazette No. 30048, Volume 505 of 6 July 2008.
- 3.8. Regulations pertaining to the Conduct, Administration and Management of assessment for the National Senior Certificate, published in the Government Gazette No. 31337, Volume 518 of 29 August 2008.
- 3.9. Minimum Admission Requirements for Higher Certificate, Diploma and Bachelor's Degree Programmes requiring a National Senior Certificate, published in the Government Gazette No.31231, Volume 751 of 11 July 2008.

- 3.10. National Curriculum Statements (NCS) Grades R – 9 and 10 -12 (General).
- 3.11. Any circular regarding the Conduct, Administration and Management of Assessment published by the Gauteng Department of Education.

#### **4. CRITERIA FOR ENTRY TO SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATIONS**

The Policy and Regulation on the Conduct, Administration and Management of the NSC determines conditions under which a supplementary examination will be granted:

- 4.1. If a candidate requires two subjects to obtain the NSC, he/she may register for the two subjects provided that these were written in the 2008 end-of-year examination. The candidate will receive an entry form for the supplementary examination with the statement of results.
- 4.2. A candidate, who did not write the examination or part thereof, has the option to write the supplementary examination only in the paper/s that he/she did not write.
- 4.3. If a candidate is medically unfit due to illness or injury and as a result was absent from one or more external examination, he/she may register for the subject(s) he/she was absent for provided that supporting documentation is produced as evidence.
- 4.4. If there was a death in the immediate family of a candidate (father, mother, sister, grandparents, husband, legal partner and children), he/she may register for any number of subjects provided that supporting documentation is produced as evidence.
- 4.5. A candidate who provides documentary evidence that he/she qualifies for admission to a higher education institution or for an occupation, but does not satisfy the higher education faculty requirements or the requirements for the specific occupation, may be allowed to register for a maximum of two subjects that were written during the end-of-year sitting.
- 4.6. In the case where an irregularity is being investigated, provisional entry may be granted to the candidate concerned, pending the outcome of the investigation.
- 4.7. Candidates mentioned in 4.2 – 4.6 above will be required to submit documentary proof to write the supplementary examination and will NOT receive an entry form with the statement of results.
- 4.8. The School Based Assessment mark (oral, practical and CASS) of candidates who wrote the October/November 2008 will be valid for a period of three years and will be used to satisfy the internal assessment requirements.

## 5. PROCEDURE FOR SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATION ENTRIES

- 5.1. Application forms for candidates as stated in paragraph 4.1 will be printed with the statement of results.
- 5.2 All the other candidates as mentioned in 4.2- 4.6 will be required to complete a separate entry form (**Annexure A**).
- 5.3 The candidate must submit his/her entry to the District office. Supplementary Examinations are not the responsibility of the school. The address of the relevant District Office may be obtained from the candidate's school or examination centre.
- 5.4 The closing date for applications is **23 January 2009**. No late entries will be accepted. No examination fees are payable for this examination.  
  
**NB:** Candidates, who will be on vacation, must ensure that they are in contact with their principals to establish whether they qualify to sit for the Supplementary Examination in February/March 2009.
- 5.5 To register for the Supplementary Examinations, candidates must produce the statement of results of the October/November 2008 Examinations from the Gauteng Department of Education and an identity document (ID) or valid driver's licence or passport or an affidavit from SAPS with an ID size photo affixed to it.
- 5.6 Candidates will write the Supplementary Examinations at centralised venues to be determined by the Department. Allocation of such venues will be reasonably near the location of the venue where the candidates originally wrote the October/November 2008 National Senior Certificate Examinations. The Examination centre will be indicated on the reverse side of the candidate's admission letter.
- 5.7 A candidate who has applied for re-marking/re-checking of the October/November 2008 examination may also register for the Supplementary Examinations.
- 5.8 Subjects changes are not permitted (i.e. candidates must write the same subjects as registered for the October/November 2008 Examinations).
- 5.9 Candidates are to provide full information on the examination entry forms.
- 5.10 Candidates are responsible for obtaining admission letters for the Supplementary Examination from the District Office where entries were submitted. The submission letter together with the candidate's Identity Document will be required before he / she is permitted to enter the examination room.

## **6. POSSIBLE CLASHES IN THE SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATION TIMETABLE**

The possibility exists that subjects/papers may clash on the examination timetable. In such cases, the following internal arrangements must be made:

- 6.1. Principals should notify the Directorate: Examinations and Assessment, by faxing to The Director: Examinations and Assessment on **(011) 355 0622**, stating the name and number of the examination centre, the candidate's name(s), the date(s) and session(s) in question and the subject(s)/paper(s) concerned, no later than the day on which the clash occurs.
- 6.2. The subject with the most candidates at that centre will be written first at the set time according to the examination timetable
- 6.3. After the session, the candidates involved must immediately be separated from the other candidates, be granted an opportunity to rest for an hour and be kept under close supervision during this period by an invigilator.
- 6.4. These candidates must under no circumstances be granted access to any kind of telephone or be allowed to make contact with other candidates or educators.
- 6.5. Candidates will then be allowed to write the second subject.

## **7. RESULTS**

- 7.1. The GDE will issue **new statements of results** to all candidates who write the Supplementary Examinations.
- 7.2. These statements of results will be obtainable on the **23 April 2009** from the District Office where the examination centre is registered.
- 7.3. The closing date to apply for the re-mark/re-check of the National Senior Certificate Supplementary Examinations answer scripts of February/March 2009 is **15 May 2009**. The application form for re-mark/re-check is obtainable from the District Office. This is the same form that was used to apply for re-mark/re-check of the October/November 2008 National Senior Certificate Examinations.
- 7.4. The results of re-marking/re-checking of the National Senior Certificate Supplementary Examinations for February/March 2009 will be obtainable from the District Office.

## **8. FURTHER INFORMATION**

The concessions that were granted to candidates with barriers to learning will be transferred from the October/November 2008 National Senior Certificate examinations to the supplementary examinations. Apply at the District Examination Concession Committee for emergency concessions.

## **9. THE EXAMINATION TIMETABLE**

A timetable for the supplementary National Senior Certificate examination in February/March 2009 is attached as **Annexure B**.
