English for Academic Purposes (EAP) Program

Program Information

For the benefit of international students whose first language is not English, the University offers an English for Academic Purposes Program. Students in the EAP program enjoy the advantage of working with four different EAP instructors each semester, experiencing a variety of teaching styles and approaches. Our qualified and experienced teachers are dedicated to providing a high standard of instruction, using contemporary teaching methods, up-to-date resources, and technological applications to enhance learning.

Program entry is available in January, May, and September each year. Note that new students must complete a placement assessment during orientation to determine their level in the EAP program. Note that we reserve the right to recommend a Beginner ESL program when a student does not place in the Intermediate level of EAP.

Each level of EAP consists of four courses: Writing, Reading, Grammar, and Communication. These four courses make a full-time program. Each course is 5 hours/week in the Fall and Spring for 13 weeks, and 6 hours/week in the Summer for 11 weeks. Note: Successful completion of the Advanced EAP level satisfies the University's English Language Proficiency Requirement for applicants to undergraduate and graduate academic programs.

Reading: Short articles, essays, stories

Grammar: Clear, more complex expressions

Communication: Longer lectures, discussion topics, and presentations

Advanced Level of EAP

Writing: Academic essays and research papers

Reading: Extended academic articles, essays, fictional pieces

Grammar: Clear, complex, and academic expressions

Communication: Academic lectures and presentations on researched topics
