SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

Scholarship Focus: Financial assistance to an individual(s) pursuing vocational training.

Scholarship Amount: The number of scholarships and the amounts will be determined annually by the Manatee Community Foundation. Payment will be forwarded by the Foundation directly to MTI financial aid office for distribution. In addition to tuition, the scholarship may cover items such as books, equipment, lab or licensing fees, uniforms and other similar expenses associated with the student's coursework.

Selection Criteria: Scholarship applicant must –

1. Be accepted into Manatee Technical Institute East.
2. Be a resident of Manatee County.

Recipient Selection: Scholarship recipients will be selected by the Manatee Community Foundation's *scholarship committee* based on the criteria stated above and a personal interview. In the event there are no qualified applicants, the scholarship will not be awarded that year.

Scholarship Award Notification: All applicants are notified in writing whether or not they received an award.
