CONDITIONS

- 1. ACCEPTANCE AND REJECTION: The City of Conway (reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to accept bids in whole or in part (unless otherwise indicated by bidder), to waive any informalities in bids received, to accept bids on materials or equipment with variations from specifications where efficiency of operation will not be impaired, and to award bids to best serve the interest of the City of Conway.
- 2. **PRICES:** Unless otherwise stated in the Bid Invitation, the following will apply: (1) unit prices shall be bid, (2) prices should be stated in units of quantity specified (feet, each, lbs., etc.), (3) prices must be F.O.B. destination specified in bid, (4) prices must be firm and not subject to escalation, (5) bid must be firm for acceptance for 30 days from bid opening date. In case of errors in extension, unit prices shall govern. Discounts from bid price will not be considered in making awards.
- BID BONDS AND PERFORMANCE BONDS: If required, a Bid Bond in the form of a cashier's check, certified check, or surety bond issued by a surety 3. company, in an amount stated in the Bid Invitation, must accompany bid. Personal and company checks are not acceptable as Bid Bonds. Failure to submit a Bid Bond as required will cause a bid to be rejected. The Bid Bond will be forfeited as liquidated damages if the successful bidder fails to provide a required Performance Bond within the period stipulated by CITY OF CONWAY or fails to honor their bid. Cashier's checks and certified checks submitted as Bid Bonds will be returned to unsuccessful bidders; surety bonds will be retained. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond in an amount stated in the Bid Invitation and in the form of a cashier's check, certified check, or surety bond issued by a surety company, unless otherwise stated in the Bid Invitation, as a guarantee of delivery of goods/services in accordance with the specifications and within the time established in the bid. Personal and company checks are not acceptable as Performance Bonds. In some cases, a cashier's check or certified check submitted as a Bid Bond will be held as the Performance Bond of the successful bidder. Cashier's checks or certified checks submitted as Performance Bonds will be refunded shortly after payment has been made to the successful bidder for completion of all terms of the bid; surety bonds will be retained. Surety bonds must be issued by a surety company authorized to do business in Arkansas, and must be signed by a Resident Local Agent licensed by the Arkansas State Insurance Commissioner to represent that surety company. Resident Agent's Power-of-Attorney must accompany the surety bond. Certain bids involving labor will require Performance Bonds in the form of surety bonds only (no checks of any kind allowed). In such cases, the company issuing the surety bond must comply with all stipulations herein and must be named in the U.S. Treasury listing of companies holding Certificates of Authority as acceptable sureties on Federal Bonds and as acceptable reinsuring companies. Any excess between the face amount of the bond and the underwriting limitation of the bonding company shall be protected by reinsurance provided by an acceptable reinsuring company.
- 4. TAXES: The CITY OF CONWAY is not exempt from Arkansas State Sales and Use Taxes, or local option city/City of Conway sales taxes, when applicable, and bidders are responsible to the State Revenue Department for such taxes. These taxes should not be included in bid prices, but where required by law, will be paid by the CITY OF CONWAY as an addition thereto, and should be added to the billing to the CITY OF CONWAY. The CITY OF CONWAY is exempt from Federal Excise Taxes on all commodities except motor fuels; and excise taxes should not be included in bid prices except for motor fuels. Where applicable, tax exemption certificates will be furnished by the CITY OF CONWAY.
- 5. "ALL OR NONE" BIDS: Bidders who wish to bid "All or None' on two or more items shall so stipulate on the face of bid sheet; otherwise, bid may be awarded on an individual item basis.
- 6. SPECIFICATIONS: Complete specifications should be attached for any substitution or alternate offered, or where amplification is necessary. Bidder's name must be placed on all attachments to the bid.
- 7. EXCEPTIONS TO SPECIFICATIONS: Any exceptions to the bid specifications must be stated in the bid. Any exceptions to manufacturer's published literature must be stated in the bid, or it will be assumed that bidder is bidding exactly as stated in the literature.
- 8. BRAND NAME REFERENCES: All brand name references in bid specifications refer to that commodity or its equivalent, unless otherwise stated in Bid Invitation. Bidder should state brand or trade name of item being bid, if such name exists.
- 9. FREIGHT: All freight charges should be included in bid price. Any change in common carrier rates authorized by the Interstate Commerce Commission will be adjusted if such change occurs after the bid opening date. Receipted common carrier bills that reflect ICC authorized rate changes must be furnished.
- 10. SAMPLES AND LITERATURE: Samples or technical literature must be provided within 14 days of CITY OF CONWAY request unless CITY OF CONWAY extends time. Failure to provide samples or literature within this period may cause bid to be rejected. When required, samples of items must be furnished free of charge, prior to or after the opening of bids, and, if not destroyed, will be returned upon request at the bidder's expense. Each individual sample must be labeled with bidder's name and item number. Request for return of samples must be made within 10 days following submission of sample. Samples from successful bidders will be retained for comparison with items actually furnished.
- 11. **GUARANTY:** Unless otherwise indicated in Bid Invitation, it is understood and agreed that any item offered or shipped on this bid shall be newly manufactured, latest model and design, and in first class condition; and that all containers shall be new, suitable for storage or shipment and in compliance with all applicable laws relating to construction, packaging, labeling and registration.
- 12. BACKORDERS OR DELAY IN DELIVERY: Backorders or failure to deliver within the time required may constitute default. Vendor must give written notice to the CITY OF CONWAY, as soon as possible, of the reason for any delay and the expected delivery date. The CITY OF CONWAY has the right to extend delivery if reasons appear valid. If reason or delivery date is not acceptable, vendor is in default.
- 13. **DEFAULT:** All commodities furnished will be subject to inspection and acceptance by CITY OF CONWAY after delivery. Default in promised delivery or failure to meet specifications authorizes the CITY OF CONWAY to cancel award or any portion of same, to reasonably purchase commodities or services elsewhere and to charge full increase, if any, in cost and handling to defaulting vendor. Applicable bonds may be forfeited.
- 14. ETHICS: "It shall be a breach of ethical standards for a person to be retained, or to retain a person, to solicit or secure a State contract upon an agreement of understanding for a commission, percentage, brokerage, or contingent fee, except for retention of bona fide employees or bona fide established commercial selling agencies maintained by the contractor for the purpose of securing business." (Arkansas Code, Annotated, Section 19-11-708).

SPECIFICATIONS

<u>FOR</u>

Crawler dozer

- 1. General: This specification is for a crawler dozer consisting of all mounted on a track type undercarriage. The machine furnished must be current model built for the U.S. market. Machines manufactured for foreign markets will not be accepted. Equipment considered conforming to this specification and meeting the requirements of the Conway Street Department include a Caterpillar D3KXL, Case 650L and a John Deere 450J.
- 2. <u>Engine</u>: Liquid cooled diesel developing no less than 74 SAE net horsepower. Shall have electrical starting equipment including starter, battery, alternator and charge indicator. Shall have governor, oil pressure actuated electric hour meter, lube oil filters and fuel filters with replaceable elements, approved dry type air cleaner and precleaner. Cooling system shall have anti-freeze protection to -20° F, or lower. All gauges or indicators, including temperature, oil pressure and charge, to be mounted in instrument panel in cab readily visible to operator from seat. Engine shall be TIER III EMISSION CERTIFIED
- 3. <u>Hydraulic System</u>: Hydraulic cylinders shall be double acting type. Hydraulic system shall be equipped with filtration system with replaceable filter elements of adequate capacity. Shall have remote test ports for testing hydraulic circuit.
- 4. <u>Travel</u>: Steering shall be controlled by single lever steering, direction control, and counter rotation. .
- 5. <u>Undercarriage</u>: Idlers and rollers shall be sealed and lubricated type. Track tension adjustment shall be hydraulic type. Maximum ground pressure of 6.5 psi.
 - A. <u>Rollers</u>: The undercarriage shall have a minimum of six (6) track rollers and a minimum of one (1) carrier roller per side.
 - B. <u>Tracks</u>: Track shoes shall have a nominal width of 16". There shall be no less than 41 track shoes per side. Overall tractor width shall not exceed 75".
- 6. <u>Controls</u>: Shall have single hydraulic joystick type controls for blade in all directions.
- 7. <u>Blade</u>: shall have 6 way blade. blade shall be no wider than 8'8"
- 8. <u>OPERATOR COMPARTMENT</u>: adjustable suspension seat and seat belt. All controls shall be easily accessible to operator including engine start, stop and throttle controls and gauges or indicators..Shall meet all OSHA specs for rollover protection (ROPS) and falling object protection (FOPS). Must have rear screen guard and limb risers in front. Shall have the ability to tilt back or over to access to internal components.
- 9. Weight: Minimum operating weight of 17,100 lbs and no more than 19,000 lbs
- 10. <u>Color</u>: Units shall be painted standard factory color.
- 11. <u>Condition of Used Equipment:</u> Conway street department personnel will inspect and test drive the equipment to determine its suitability and appropriateness for the needs of the City of Conway as well as the comparative prices of the bids submitted. The bidder shall make available the unit for inspection before bids are received or as otherwise coordinated a review of the unit with the city.
- 12. <u>Warranty</u>: Dozer purchased under this specification shall be warranted against defects in materials and workmanship for a minimum period of twelve (12) months from the date dozer is placed in service. Warranty shall include all parts, labor and any travel expense for the service call or hauling to and from the location. This is a minimum warranty required in order for a bid to be considered. Any warranty by the manufacturer on components of the machine purchased that exceeds the minimum warranty specified (and is so advertised and included in manufacturer's printed data sheets) shall be passed on to the CITY OF CONWAY.
- 13. The successful bidder shall furnish Operator's Instruction Manual with each excavator and provide a Shop Repair Manuals and Parts Manuals on computer media (CD ROM, Floppy Disks, etc.) or book format. Machine must have any computer diagnostic equipment supplied including all software and hardware.
- 14. Units shall be assembled, adjusted and made ready for continuous operation at time of delivery.

All parts, accessories and tools necessary for satisfactory operation of this unit shall be furnished whether or not they are specifically mentioned in these specifications (including standard equipment as regularly furnished by manufacturer as shown on printed literature and specifications - unless specifically excluded by this specification).

- 15. <u>Training</u>: The successful bidder shall furnish qualified personnel to instruct CITY OF CONWAY operators and service technicians on operation and maintenance of units purchased under this specification. In addition, the successful bidder shall furnish information on any factory service schools which would be available for CITY OF CONWAY service technicians.
- 16. The successful bidder shall maintain a representative inventory of replacement parts and service facilities for servicing equipment bid on with in a radius of 60 miles.
- 17. City of Conway reserves the right to require a demonstration, under actual working conditions, of machine bid under this specification before award is made. City of Conway reserves the right to accept or reject any bid in the best interest of the City of Conway
