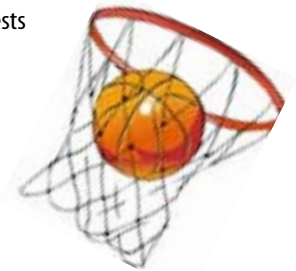
Our camp features a high number of coaches per player. We make this possible by having our sophomore and varsity players work as coaches. Learn the game with your favorite RAM!
