_____ **WCSH 6 Bill Green's Maine Intern** (applications deadline for Fall semester is June 15th, Spring semester and January term is Oct 15th. Summer semester is March 15th) – Opportunity to get acquainted with a weekly magazine format program featuring Maine recreation, people and places.

_____ **WCSH 6 207 Intern** (applications deadline for Fall semester is June 15th. Spring semester and January term is Oct 15th, Summer semester is March 15th) -- 207 is a live, local half-hour newsmagazine program that airs M-F from 7-7:30PM. Content covers everything from hard news and politics to entertainment to cooking to the arts. Interns will be involved in various aspects of production both in the studio and in the field.

_____ **WCSH 6 Community Relations Intern** (applications deadline for Fall semester is June 15th, Spring semester and January term is Oct 15th, Summer semester is March 15th) -- Opportunity to work in Community Relations including assisting in all phases of station project development and community outreach.
